Narrative:

The following is a synopsis of the information provided by Mr. Wiseman in a telephone conversation on this date:

- Mr. Wiseman worked for his father at the FBO, Wiseman Aviation at KFLG
- The pilot and his wife had left the airplane with Wiseman Aviation upon their arrival in KLFG on Saturday May 25
- The couple "needed help with their luggage" [to move it from the car to the airplane]
- Mr. Wiseman used the FBO "golf cart" to transport some luggage and the wife to the airplane
- The luggage that he transported consisted of 5 "book bags" and a briefcase
- He described the book bags as being similar to canvas/cloth grocery bags
- One contained 2 or 3 bottles of wine, one contained shoes and possibly some snacks, and the other three contained books and/or magazines.
- Regarding the book bags, there was "nothing particularly heavy"
- The briefcase appeared to hold a "Macbook Pro" laptop and an iPad, and possibly some other small items or papers
- The wife loaded the book bags into the aft area on the floor between the forward and aft-facing seats
- The pilot loaded the two suitcases behind the forward-facing (aft-most) rear seats
- Mr. Wiseman did not touch or lift those suitcases
- He observed the pilot adding oil to the airplane engine, but he did not pay attention as to how much
