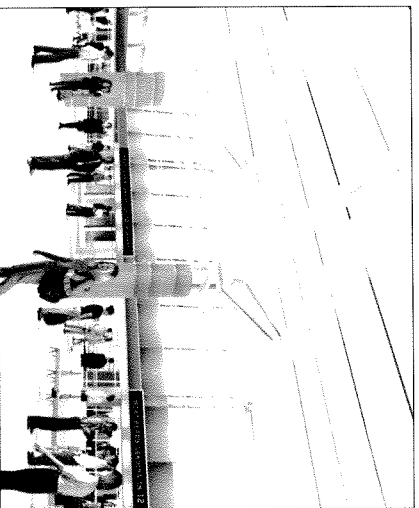


Expansive New Terminals

Staten Island Ferry passengers have inquired about the exciting transformations they see underway at the St. George and Whitehall Ferry Terminals. When completed in 2004, ongoing renovations will establish truly modern transportation hubs for over 65,000 daily riders. Sunny, expansive architecture will feature a 40-foot glass ceiling in the waiting room at St. George and a 75-foot glass entry at Whitehall. Soaring indoor spaces will be matched by more than 120,000 square feet of outdoor piazzas that provide spectacular views of the waterfront.

Passengers at St. George may enjoy enhanced dining options, and a new outdoor promenade will ease existing pedestrian access between Bay Street and the terminal.



Whitehall passengers will be served by 7,000 square feet of new retail space, while the 33% larger waiting room will provide direct passenger access to ferry loading. A redesign of Peter Minuit Plaza in front of the terminal, pending completion of a new South Ferry subway station, will create an attractive public space with multiple transit links.

Both terminals will have entirely new heating and air conditioning systems and new restrooms with safety features like non-slip floors. On-site parking facilities for motorists at St. George and for cyclists at both locations will be expanded.

State-of-the Art Ferryboats

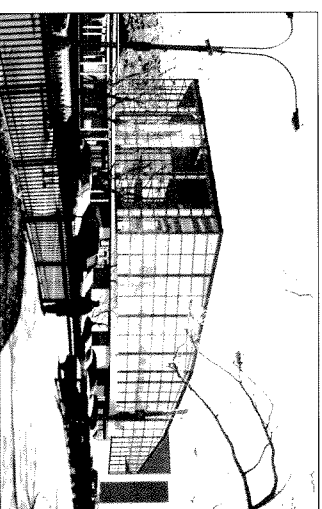
Passengers sailing between the sparkling new terminals will be treated to a more comfortable commute when the first of three fully modernized new ferryboats enters service in 2004. The boats are modeled on the beloved Kennedy Class but will have greater capacity and more amenities.

The terminals and boats are being financed through a combination of Federal, State, and City funds. The New York City Department of Transportation appreciates the patience and cooperation of all our passengers as we strive to bring state-of-the-art transportation to Staten Island Ferry riders.
