

LOWER SKIN PANEL - WING CENTER TANK

These are three small pieces of lower wing skin that are located approx at the left SOB and extends from S-13 to S-15.

The only portion of the stringer that is attached to these pieces is on CW-219 and that is only a 9" long segment of the skin flange of the S-15 splice stringer. The sections are curved and twisted and the edges all exhibit ductile failures. There is a small vertical puncture thru CW-218 just aft of where the skin flange of the S-15 stringer was attached. The fastener holes common to the S-15 splice stringer are elongated fore/aft and slightly inbd on the fwd side. The outbd edge of CW-218 at LBL 100 is bent down and the aft/inbd edge is deflected upwards near LBL 95.

The sections are slightly sooted on the interior and moderately to heavily sooted on the exterior. See the Fire and Explosion Group notes for further documentation.
