 1-13-97-44 Red trawl line N7059 SS30-31EW

(TWA IPC indicates only two tanks, thus original tank at RBL 55 must have been deleted from A/P.)

Fiberglass - honeycomb tanks are both fractured into top and bottom parts, in the top attach flange area. Inner and outer face plys and core show multiple fractures. No indication of soot.

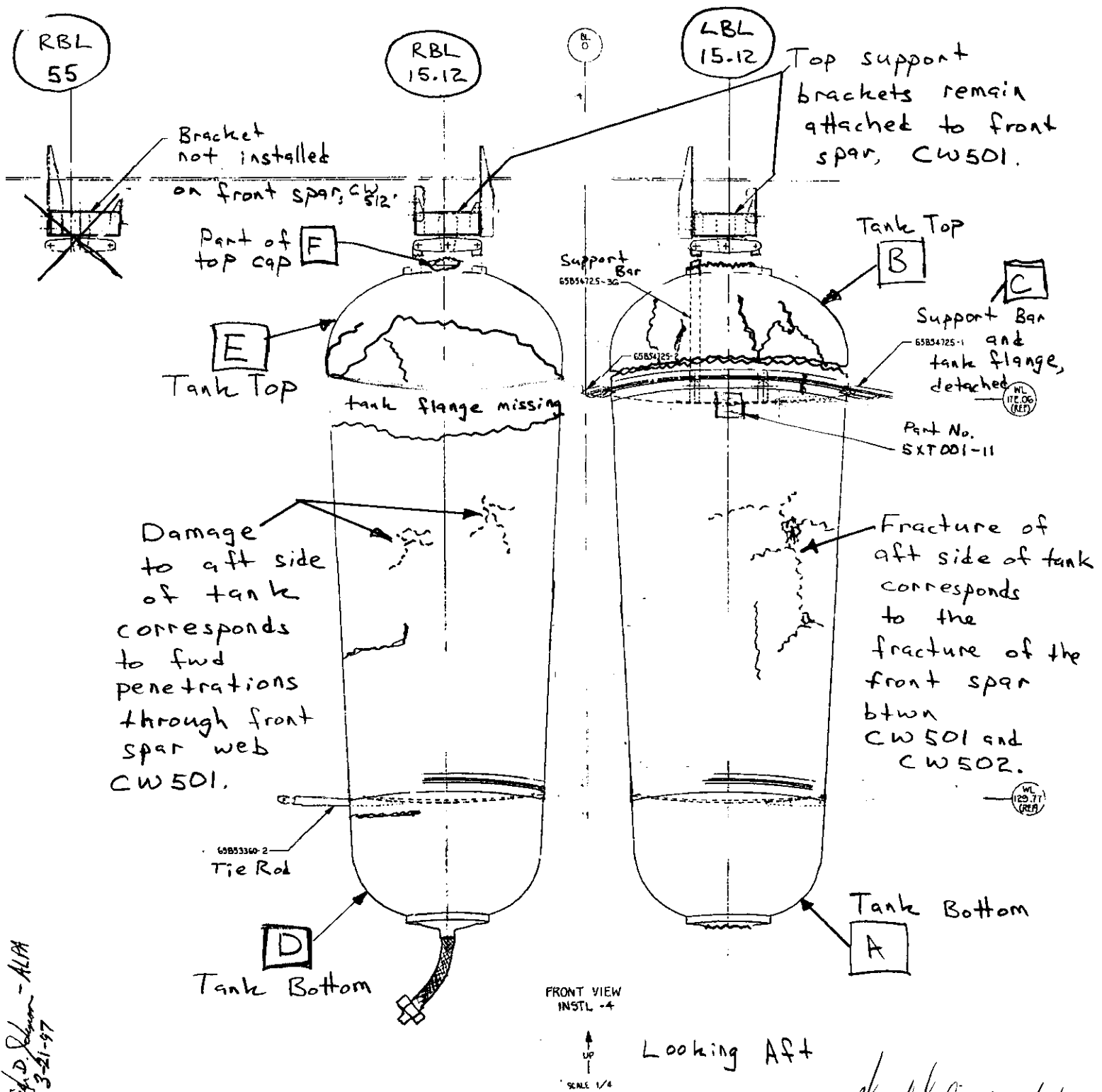
