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RHS skin segment, STA 1170 to 1500, S-7R to S-24R.

Most frames and all stringers remain attached to the panel. The fwd door edge frame is not attached. The aft edge frame is intact down to stop #2 (8 stops remain). The forward most portion of this panel is folded sharply near STA 1241.

There is a moderate coating of soot or dirt on the exterior of the panel segment. The interior is very lightly sooted. There is a

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drastic contrast between this panel and Door 3R (RF28), which exhibits significant burn damage and sooting.

The glass is still intact at the first window aft of the Door. The pane is moderately sooted with the interior surface smooth and the exterior slightly roughened.

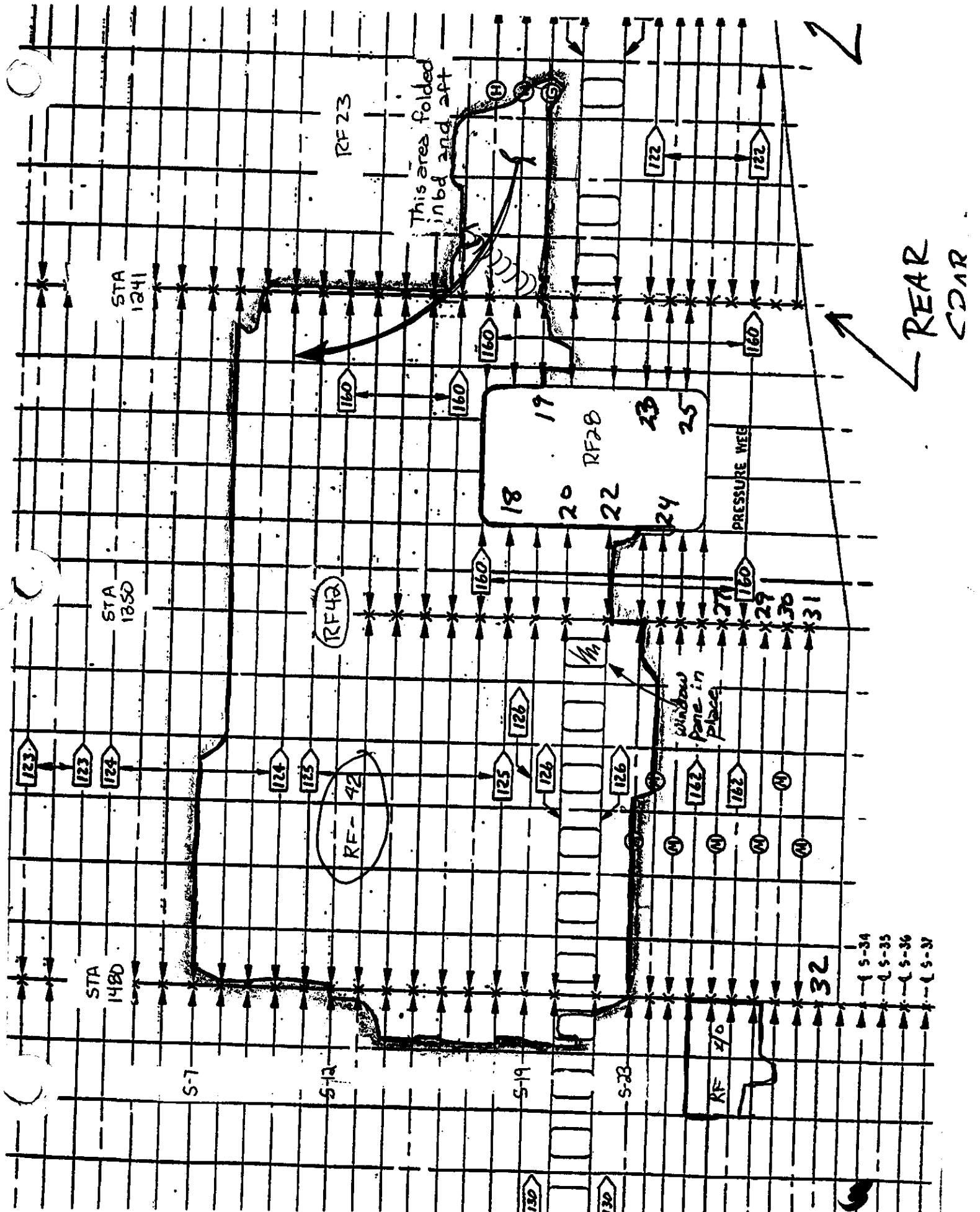
The outboard section of the lift-off beam remains attached to the panel. The web from the frame inner chord to the next beam stiffener (~10 inches) is still relatively flat and intact.
