REFER FIRE AND EXPLOSION GROUP NOTES FOR FIRE DAMAGE

C232

RIGHT HAND WING LOWER SKIN PANEL

THE PIECE EXTENDS FROM WS 1196 TO WS 1364 AND FROM THE FRONT SPAR TO STRINGER 10. IT IS BUCKLED CHORDWISE BETWEEN WS 1196 AND WS 1280 WITH THE CENTER PUSHED UP RELATIVE TO THE FRONT SPAR AND STR 10.

STRINGERS 10, 11, 12, AND 13 REMAIN PARTIALLY ATTACHED TO SKIN BETWEEN WS 1224 AND WS 1300 (APPROX) WITH SOOTING VISIBLE ON THE UPPER HALF OF ALL 4 STRINGERS OVER ABOUT HALF THE LENGTH OF EACH.

SOOTING IS ALSO APPARENT ON THE FRONT SPAR LOWER CHORD FROM WS 1252 TO WS 1280 ON THE HORIZONTAL FLANGE, WHICH REMAINS ATTACHED TO THE SKIN. THE FRACTURE FACE ALSO IS SOOTED.

THE PANEL OUTBD FROM WS 1280 REMAINS RELATIVELY FLAT.

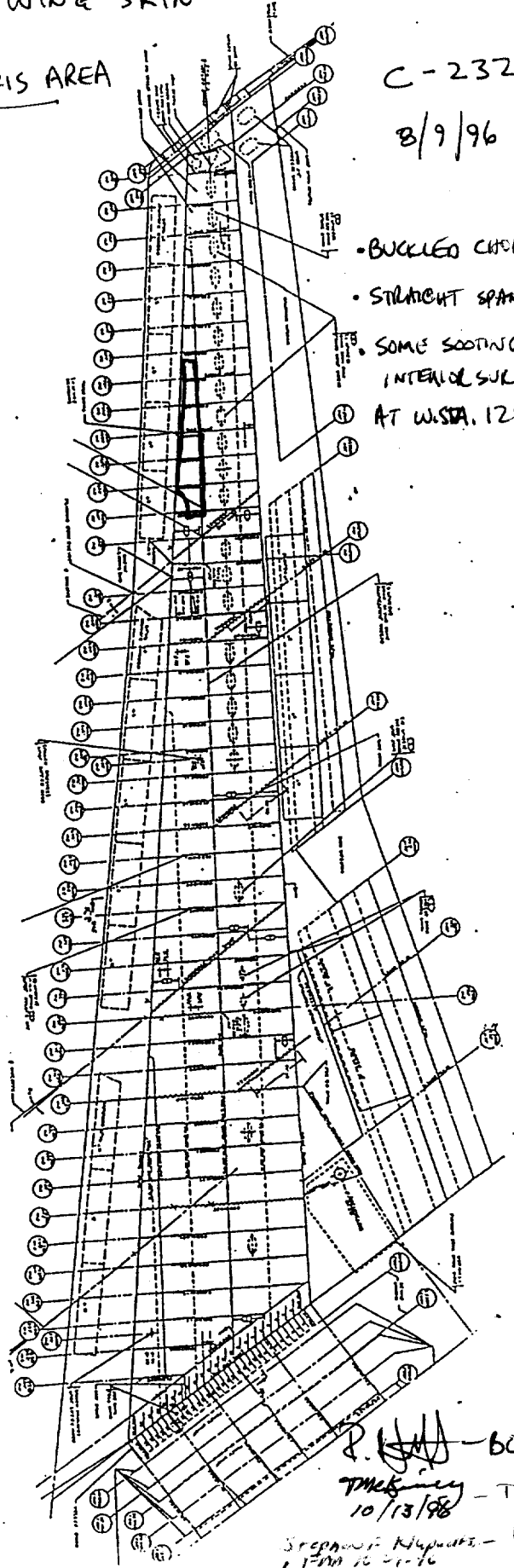
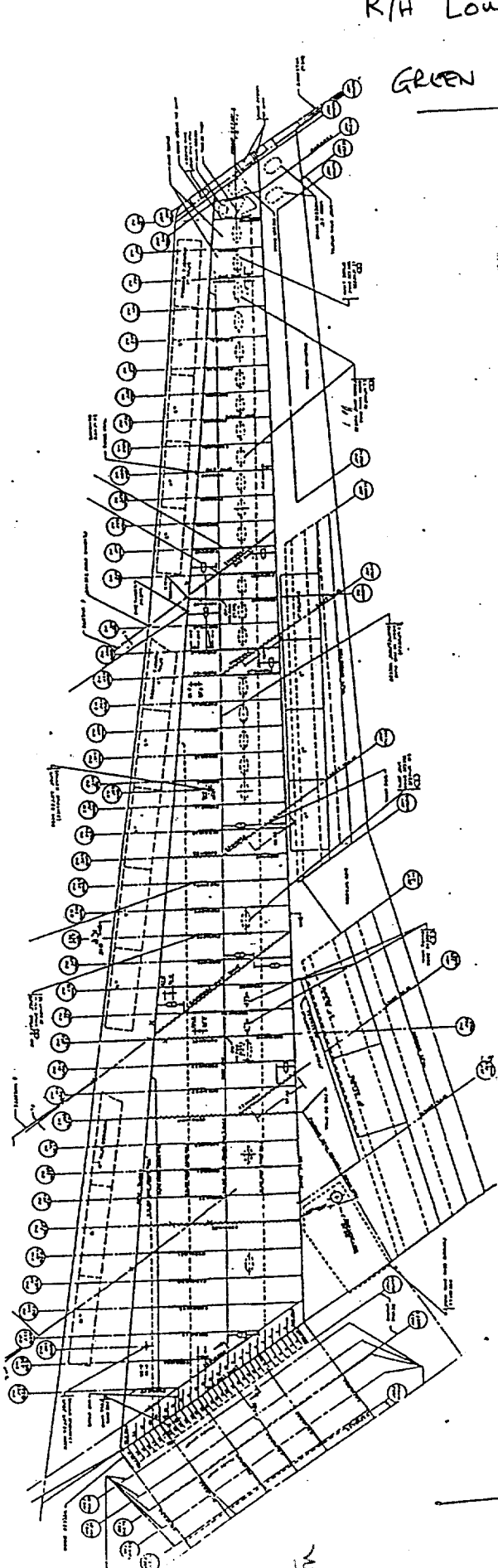
