7	walk me into where I'm supposed to be? I'm at the off ramp of 35
8	of 280.
9	AREA COMM: Water Tender, we're in San Bruno at San
10	Bruno Avenue and Claremont.
11	WATER TENDER 57: Copy. Thanks.
12	UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: (indiscernible).
13	OPERATIONS: South Branch from Operations on 31.
14	Training 5 from Operations on 31.
15	MEDICAL GROUP: IC, from Medical Group.
16	IC: IC, go ahead.
17	MEDICAL GROUP: We're just checking in with you. We
18	have established two, two medical groups. We are two medical
19	groups together. We have pagers going different directions. So
20	we have the MR supervisor at the Medical Group North. The Medical
21	Group South will be at San Bruno and Skyline. We have Life Flight
22	on deck. We transported a total of five patients. I had Med 20
23	heading to the Medical Group North at this time.
24	COMMUNICATIONS: South Branch, Communications on
25	Command.

1 OPERATIONS: South Branch, go to Operations. 2 COMMUNICATIONS: South Branch, Communications. Can I 3 get a par? 4 SOUTH BRANCH: Slow down a little bit and repeat, 5 traffic -- a lot of traffic here. 6 COMMUNICATIONS: Can I get a par of your branch? 7 OPERATIONS: Training 5 from Operations on 31. RECON: Operations, this is Recon. I'm near the 8 9 (indiscernible) traffic. 10 NORTH BRANCH: Operations, North Branch. 11 COMMAND 31: Area Comm, Command 31. 12 OPERATIONS: Training 5, you are South Branch. Training 5 is South Branch. 13 14 Command 31, go ahead to Comm. AREA COMM: 15 COMMAND 31: Comm 80 is in the area. Confirm you want 16 her at Glenview and San Bruno or Lunardi's? 17 AREA COMM: You broke up. Say again. 18 COMMAND 31: Comm 80, she's in the area. Do you want 19 her at Glenview and San Bruno or are you at Lunardi's? 20 The command post, just north of San Bruno AREA COMM: 21 Avenue. 22 COMMAND 31: 10-4. Area Comm, Command 31 for the fuel. 23 AREA COMM: Go ahead. 24 COMMAND 31: Their ETA is 20 minutes, 1300 gallons of 25 diesel.

1 AREA COMM: What's the resource identifier and where 2 they're coming from?

3 COMMAND 31: Okay. 500 gallons of unleaded is coming 4 from San Francisco and I'll try to get you the identifier. 5 Copy that. Let's have them on White 2. AREA COMM: 6 COMMAND 31: 10-4, sending them to White 2. 7 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, Communications on Command. OPERATIONS: South Branch from Operations on 31. 8 The 9 electrical power is down on the west side of the fire. The electrical is down on the west side of the fire. 10 11 South Branch, I need a par from your branch. NORTH BRANCH: Operations, North Branch. 12 13 OPERATIONS: West Branch, standby. North Branch, go to 14 Operations. 15 NORTH BRANCH: Operations, North Branch. Do we have any 16 available units to respond to Concord and Fairmont to assist 17 Engine 64? They said they have a water supply. Three structures 18 on the street are burning. 19 OPERATIONS: That's affirm. We'll get a unit from 20 staging, and they're going to Concord and what? 21 NORTH BRANCH: Concord and Fairmont, Concord and 22 Fairmont, and standby for a couple. I may be moving North Branch 23 to that location. 24 OPERATIONS: Copy that. 25 Communications from Operations.

1

COMMUNICATIONS: Go ahead.

2 OPERATIONS: If you have, whatever you have in staging, 3 I need one engine to the North Branch. I need one engine to West 4 Branch.

5 COMMUNICATIONS: Copy that, and just for your 6 information, I'm setting up for Command 51, Command 5-1, for 7 Operations. I'll advise.

8 OPERATIONS: Copy.

9 COMMUNICATIONS: Staging manager, staging manager,10 Communications on Command.

11 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: You said you're (indiscernible)
12 15?

13 OPERATIONS: South Branch, Operations, (indiscernible)14 Operations.

15 NORTH BRANCH: (indiscernible) unit for North Branch on 16 31, go.

17 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: (indiscernible) Communications to18 staging manager.

19 OPERATIONS: South Branch, Operations.

20 NORTH BRANCH: Operations, are you calling North Branch?
 21 OPERATIONS: Okay. North Branch, I'm getting an engine
 22 sent over to you.

23 NORTH BRANCH: Copy. I want them at Concord and

24 Fairmont, Concord and Fairmont.

25 Operations, North Branch.

OPERATIONS: North Branch to Operations.

2 NORTH BRANCH: Just a status report. We've got the 1800 3 block of Claremont fairly well covered with Truck 95, Engine 94 4 and 92, with 71. I'm going to go ahead and move North Branch to 5 Concord and Fairmont.

6 OPERATIONS: Copy that.

7 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, Communications on Command.
8 OPERATIONS: Go ahead to Operations.

9 COMMUNICATIONS: For the North Branch, the engine will

10 be Engine 44, 4-4. For the West Branch, it's Engine 1-5, 15.

11 OPERATIONS: Copy, 44.

12 COMMAND 31: Area Comm, Command 31.

13 COMMUNICATIONS: All units on 31, Communications will be 14 off the air for about one minute.

15 OPERATIONS: South Branch from Operations on 31.

16 East Branch from Operations. East Branch from

17 Operations on 31.

18 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, Communications on Command.

19 OPERATIONS: Communications, go ahead to Operations.

20 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, Communications. Comm units 21 are going to be moving over to Command 51. I'm going to be

22 talking to center on that channel. All resource requests will be

23 there. So if you need anything from the Comm unit, contact me on

24 51.

25

OPERATIONS: Copy. All Channel 31 resource orders go on

1 51.

2 COMMUNICATIONS: Affirmative. You can keep all your 3 operations on Command 31.

4 OPERATIONS: Copy that. South Branch, Battalion 6 from 5 Operations.

6 WEST BRANCH: West Branch.

7 OPERATIONS: West Branch, go ahead, Operations.

8 COMM: OPS, Comm on 31.

9 OPERATIONS: Go ahead. This is Ops on 31.

10 COMM: The (indiscernible) is going to move south to the 11 incident command post, where unified command is set up. They're 12 looking for a resource status and restaff which I have a good 13 picture of. So I'm going to meet with them up there.

14 OPERATIONS: Confirming you're going to come out where 15 the command post was.

16 WEST BRANCH: Operations, West Division or West Branch.

17 OPERATIONS: West Branch, go to operations.

18 COMM: Copy that. Is there a Ford vehicle

19 (indiscernible) -- standby.

20 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, Communications 31.

21 Operations, Communications on Command 31.

22 OPERATIONS: Go ahead, Communications.

23 COMMUNICATIONS: The San Francisco fuel truck,

24 correction, fuel tender is en route, ETA probably 10 to 15, 500

25 gallons of unleaded and a lot more of the regular stuff.

1 OPERATIONS: Copy that. I'll get to the branches and see what they're going to need. Can you advise when we have some 2 3 units in staging and get some relief for these crews? 4 COMMUNICATIONS: I have a staging manager right here. 5 I'll advise. Standby. 6 OPERATIONS: Copy that. 7 STAGING MANAGER: Communications, staging manager. MEDICAL GROUP: IC, Medical Group. 8 9 OPERATIONS: South Branch Battalion 6 from Operations. Battalion 6, Battalion 6, from Operations. 10 11 BATTALION 6: Go ahead, Operations. 12 WEST DIVISION: West Division, go. 13 OPERATIONS: West Division, go to Ops. (indiscernible) 14 from Operations. 15 North Branch, I just want you, when you get a chance, do 16 a par over on your units over there and you can advise when you 17 have a par while you're there. 18 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, Comm. 19 OPERATIONS: South Branch from Operations on 31. South 20 Branch from Operations on 31. 21 NORTH BRANCH: Operations, North Branch on 31. 22 OPERATIONS: Go ahead, North Branch. NORTH BRANCH: Yeah, I'm at 1150 Fairmont, 1-1-5-0 23 24 Fairmont. If I could get all available engines into this area. 25 Bill, we're going to need to set up some exposure lines to prevent

1 some other houses from burning.

2 OPERATIONS: Confirming you have 1150 Fairmont. You 3 need -- can you use three engines right now?

4 NORTH BRANCH: That's affirmative, and we can get the 5 reserve out of Station 52. They're ready to come. My situation 6 here, I have multiple homes, at least six to eight homes on fire, 7 in the 11- or 1200 block of Fairmont. I want to set up some 8 exposure lines on both sides of the street, and we're going to 9 need some additional resources just west of us. I'm not sure what 10 that street is.

OPERATIONS: Copy that. I'm going to send what I have available to you in staging. I'll see. I'll send you three initial engines for you assigned to the North Branch.

14 NORTH BRANCH: That's affirmative. Thank you.

15 OPERATIONS: Communications from Operations.

16 COMMUNICATIONS: Ops, go ahead to Comm.

17OPERATIONS: Comm, this is Operations. I need three18engines to 1150 Claremont, three engines to 1150 Claremont.

19 They'll be assigned to the North Branch.

20 COMMUNICATIONS: Staging, this is Communications, on 21 Command.

22 RECON: Ops to Recon.

23 OPERATIONS: South Branch, Battalion 6, from Operations.24 NORTH BRANCH: Go ahead to North.

25 OPERATIONS: South Branch from Operations. I need a

1 par.

2 NORTH BRANCH: It's going to be difficult. On 3 Claremont, we have Engine 86, Engine 94, Engine 71, Engine 63, 4 (indiscernible) 61, Breathing Support 86 and Battalion 17, 18, 5 Truck 95 and Quint 62. 6 OPERATIONS: Copy that. That's on North Branch? 7 NORTH BRANCH: That's affirmative. It's on North I also have Engine 24 but I have not seen them yet and I 8 Branch. 9 have no, no apparatus on Fairmont yet. 10 OPERATIONS: Copy that. I have three engines ordered to 11 go over to 1150 Claremont. They'll be reporting to you. 12 NORTH BRANCH: Copy. 13 OPERATIONS: South Branch from Operations on 31. 14 SOUTH BRANCH: Go ahead, Ops. This is South Branch. 15 OPERATIONS: South Branch, I need a par now. I need a 16 par from your units and your coverage right now. 17 SOUTH BRANCH: Copy that. I got -- hold on a minute. 18 I've got three on Engine 33, three on Engine 51, three on Engine 19 34 and three on Engine 95. 20 OPERATIONS: Okay. I copy 3, 3, 3, on 51, 34 and 95. Ι 21 need your other unit. 22 SOUTH BRANCH: Those are all the units we have and 23 Training 5 with 1. 24 OPERATIONS: Copy. Training 5 with 1. You have Truck 25 51 also?

1 SOUTH BRANCH: That's negative. OPERATIONS: Where is Truck 51? 2 3 SOUTH BRANCH: Ops, hold on. Ops standby. In South Branch, 3 on P-51. 4 5 RECON: Operations, Recon. 6 COMMUNICATIONS: Go ahead to Operations. 7 OPERATIONS: Communications from, Communications from 8 Operations. 9 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, go ahead. 10 OPERATIONS: Communications from Operations. 11 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, go ahead. 12 OPERATIONS: Have you sent the NSO North Branch yet, 3 13 engine companies? 14 COMMUNICATIONS: It's been requested through staging. 15 OPERATIONS: I need three engines to the North Branch at 16 I also need three engines for the South Branch. 1150 Claremont. 17 COMMUNICATIONS: Copy that. 18 C28: Area Communications, C28. 19 SOUTH BRANCH: South Branch. OPERATIONS: Battalion 6, Battalion 6, from Operations. 20 21 SOUTH BRANCH: Operations, South Branch. 22 EAST BRANCH: Operations, this is East Branch, Battalion 6, go ahead, on Command 31. 23 24 OPERATIONS: Copy. East Branch, this is Operations. Do 25 you have a par and do you have any resource needs?

UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: (indiscernible) whole sector if
 we don't get it down.

3 EAST BRANCH: Okay. I have Engine 72 par 3, Engine 17 4 par 3, Engine 1769 par 4, Battalion 6 par 1. No resource needs at this time. Should the fire get into the Canyon and work its way 5 6 up the east side, I'm going to need some more resources. 7 OPERATIONS: Copy that. You have Engine 72, Engine 17, Engine 1769 and Battalion 6, in the East Branch. No needs at this 8 9 time. 10 BATTALION 6: That's correct, and we're operating on 11 Crestmoor, Crestmoor in the area of Lexington. 12 OPERATIONS: Copy, Crestmoor and Lexington. 13 EAST BRANCH: Operations, yeah, correct that. That's 14 Kingston. 15 OPERATIONS: Copy that. Crestmoor and Kingston. 16 NORTH BRANCH: Operations, North Branch. 17 OPERATIONS: North Branch, go. 18 NORTH BRANCH: I want to make sure that we have an 19 evacuation order in place for the streets that are west of 20 Fairmont at Concord and we have to go at least two blocks east of 21 that. Has that been taken care of? 22 OPERATIONS: I'm just going to confirm those. Concord 23 and --NORTH BRANCH: Fairmont. 24 25 OPERATIONS: -- Fairmont, an evacuation for Concord and

1 Fairmont. I'll let you know.

2 NORTH BRANCH: Yeah, we need the entire Concord-3 Claremont area evacuated.

4 OPERATIONS: Copy that.

5 IC from Operations on 31. IC from Operations on 31.
6 NORTH BRANCH: Operations, North Branch.

7 COMMUNICATIONS: Command 31 from Communications.

8 Communications will be off the air for approximately five minutes.

9 SOUTH BRANCH: South Branch.

10 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Get the water supply from the 11 truck and put it the engine --

12 NORTH BRANCH: Operations, North Branch.

13 OPERATIONS: North Branch, go ahead, Operations.

14 NORTH BRANCH: I need to make sure that whatever engines 15 you're sending to Fairmont have the ability to draft from a water 16 tender.

17 OPERATIONS: Confirm, you need them to draft, they need 18 to be able to draft from the water tender?

19 NORTH BRANCH: That's affirmative. That's on advice 20 from Battalion 110.

21 OPERATIONS: Copy that.

22 Communications from Operations on 31.

23 COMMUNICATIONS: Communications is moving their

24 operation to another location. Be down for 05 minutes.

25 SOUTH BRANCH: Ops from South Branch. Ops from South

1 Branch.

2	OPERATIONS: Communications from Operations on 31.
3	SOUTH BRANCH: Operations from South Branch.
4	OPERATIONS: South Branch, go ahead to Operations.
5	SOUTH BRANCH: Please send me two more engine companies.
6	I need manpower.
7	OPERATIONS: Copy that.
8	Communications from Operations on 31.
9	UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: They said they were moving.
10	They'll be back in a little bit.
11	OPERATIONS: IC from Operations on 31.
12	NORTH BRANCH: Operations, North Branch.
13	OPERATIONS: North Branch, go ahead to Operations.
14	NORTH BRANCH: Is there any chances of getting any more
15	air drops on this? We're going to lose several more houses.
16	OPERATIONS: I understand we're (indiscernible), and
17	that'll be about the last air drops we get. I'll try to get
18	confirmation.
19	NORTH BRANCH: Copy. Status report: multiple homes
20	burning on Fairmont and down Concord Avenue, at least six homes on
21	Concord. I believe we have some units down that way but I'm not
22	sure. I'm not sure if that's West Branch or not.
23	OPERATIONS: Copy that.
24	West Branch from Operations.
25	NORTH BRANCH: Ops from North Branch. That would be

1 East Branch, East Branch.

2 OPERATIONS: Copy that. Or East Branch. 3 East Branch from Operations on 31. 4 EAST BRANCH: This is East Branch on Command 31, go 5 ahead, Operations. 6 OPERATIONS: What's your conditions now and do you need 7 any resources? EAST BRANCH: At this time conditions have not changed. 8 9 We have heavy smoke coming over us with lots of wind, some ashes, 10 nothing exposed as of yet. 11 OPERATIONS: Copy that. 12 IC from Operations on 31. South Branch, South Branch from IC on 31. 13 IC: 14 SOUTH BRANCH: South Branch, go. North. 15 OPERATIONS: South Branch from Operations on 31. If you 16 need to move that engine back, let's make sure we get it moved. 17 IC: Operations, IC on Command. 18 OPERATIONS: Go ahead to Operations, IC. 19 Let's go ahead and switch to Command 31. IC: Okay. 20 I'll get a Command channel. I want you to advise the branches, 21 you're operations. We'll have the IC command post up here at the service station, unified with law enforcement. Additionally, air 22 tac has flown over. You have 25 to 30 structures involved, about 23 24 10 acres of vegetation, seems to be not a big problem at this 25 particular time. Copter will continue to drop until they feel

1 it's unsafe to do so, and when you can give me a report on what
2 you've got going, I'd appreciate it.

3 OPERATIONS: Copy that. With the unified command, I'm 4 going to need evacuation at Fairmont and Concord. I need there 5 for evacuation on the North Branch, Fairmont and Concord.

6 Communications from Operations on 31.

7 COMMUNICATIONS: Go ahead, Ops.

8 OPERATIONS: Just checking on the resource order. I 9 needed three engines in the North Branch with drafting capability. 10 I need three engines in the South Branch. I just need personnel. 11 I don't need the equipment.

12 COMMUNICATIONS: Three in the North and what else? 13 OPERATIONS: I need three companies, engines on the 14 North Branch with drafting capabilities. I need three companies 15 on the South just for manpower. They don't need their engines 16 with them.

17 COMMUNICATIONS: Copy that.

18 WILDLAND BRANCH: Operations, Wildland Branch, on19 Command 31.

20 IC: Operations, IC.

21 OPERATIONS: Operations, go ahead.

IC: I wasn't able to copy the location that you're requesting to be evacuated.

24 OPERATIONS: Evacuation area is going to be Fairmont,
25 Concord. Fairmont and Concord. It's actually 1155 Claremont.

IC: Operations, 1155 Claremont for Fairmont and Concord
 evacuation.

3 OPERATIONS: That's affirmative. And they can check4 with the North Branch when they get there.

5 IC: Copy.

6 WILDLAND BRANCH: Operations, Wildland Branch on Command 7 31.

OPERATIONS: Go ahead, Wildland, from Operations. 8 9 WILDLAND BRANCH: Okay. Ron, I have a strike team of 10 (indiscernible) Type 3's at the end of Earl. They're starting a 11 hose lay behind the houses to do structure protection behind the houses on the south side of Earl, break. If you need another 12 13 strike team, I can send them to you on the North Branch if you 14 want to do some direct fire tac there. I have 9140 Charlie I can 15 send to the North Branch.

OPERATIONS: Copy. Go ahead and repeat one more time.
You started a hose lay on the South Branch. Are you working with
Battalion 6, South Branch?

19 WILDLAND BRANCH: I'm working with Battalion 5 at the 20 end of Earl where the origin of the incident was, where the main 21 explosion was. At the end of Earl, we're starting a hose lay 22 working from the west to the east, direct behind the houses, 23 break. We're going to call that Division P Zulu. Additionally, I 24 have an additional strike team that I can send to the North Branch 25 for that drafting and direct fire tac operation if you need them,

1 and that would 9140 Charlie.

2 OPERATIONS: Copy that. You're going to be Division 3 Zulu, Division Zulu.

4 WILDLAND BRANCH: Negative. I'm going to be the 5 Wildland Branch helping you with your wild land situation. 6 OPERATIONS: Copy that. You'll be Wildland Branch. 7 WILDLAND BRANCH: And if you'll give me a reporting location for the strike team on the North Branch, I'll send them 8 9 your way. OPERATIONS: Yeah, standby on that. 10 11 North Branch from Operations on 31. North Branch, 12 Operations on 31. NORTH BRANCH: Operations, go ahead, North. 13

14 OPERATIONS: North Branch, can you give me resource 15 needs up here? I've got the three drafting engines are minimum 16 send up. Did you need more resources up there?

17 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Battalion 104, I have a command18 post of Glenview and West San Bruno Ave.

19 NORTH BRANCH: Operations, North Branch. I don't have 20 any of those three drafting engines here yet. Can you give me 21 their numbers?

OPERATIONS: Yeah, standby. I'll have to find out what they are. Is that enough resource for you? Just give me a resource order now, and I'll find out what we can get you. NORTH BRANCH: If we get those three, with some water,

we'll be fine because we're going to be rotating water tenders.
 I'm also putting Engine 1-5-2 on the North Branch assisting on
 Fairmont.

OPERATIONS: Copy that, and advise when you need some -want any relief if we get some relief engines in there for you.
NORTH BRANCH: Yeah, copy. We're fine for now. I'll
advise.

8 WILDLAND BRANCH: Operations, Wildland Branch. So do 9 you want that strike team for North Branch or no?

10 OPERATIONS: Standby for now. Let me just find out 11 where they're at.

12 WILDLAND BRANCH: Okay.

OPERATIONS: Communications from Operations on 31.
 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, Communications. Your
 strike team is inbound from Tanforan to Branch 1, correction,
 North Branch.

OPERATIONS: Copy that strike team. They also have a strike team also -- I'm not sure where they're at. Right now they're with the Wildland Branch. Do you want me to put them in staging?

21 COMMUNICATIONS: Ops, Comm. Confirm you have a strike 22 team that's unassigned right now and available?

23 OPERATIONS: That's affirmative. We have a strike team 24 unassigned.

25 COMMUNICATIONS: Copy that. Put them in staging.

OPERATIONS: Wildland Branch from Operations.
 COMMUNICATIONS: Confirm it's Alameda or the San

3 Francisco strike team.

4 OPERATIONS: Standby. Wildland Branch from Operations.
5 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, Communications. Confirm
6 the unassigned strike team is Alameda or is it San Francisco?

7 IC: Operations, IC on Command.

8 OPERATIONS: Go ahead, IC to Operations.

9 IC: I need to get one of you from Operations to come up 10 here and be with myself in planning in order to put a plan 11 together that works for all of us. So if you want to send a 12 deputy ops up here, or leave ops, it's your choice, but if you can 13 get up here right away, I'd appreciate it.

14 OPERATIONS: Copy that. The I&I will be coming up.15 IC: IC, copy.

16 EAST BRANCH: Operations from East Branch, Command 31.
 17 OPERATIONS: Go ahead, Operations.

EAST BRANCH: Operations, I've got a report of some possible looters in the area of Trenton and Charleston, if you could pass that on to PD. There's no lights and pretty much everybody's evacuated out of here. We're getting reports from oddball people in the area.

23 OPERATIONS: Copy that.

24 South Branch from Operations on 31. South Branch from 25 Operations on 31.

1 IC: Operations, IC.

2 OPERATIONS: IC, go to Ops.

3 IC: Just to let you know, the request for the evacuation has been put through and just advise when completed. 4 5 OPERATIONS: Copy that. Be advised also we have 6 apparently some looters going at Trenton and Charleston, Trenton 7 and Charleston, there's reported looters. 8 IC: Trenton and Charleston, copy. We'll relay that to 9 law enforcement. 10 OPERATIONS: South Branch from Operations on 31. 11 West Branch from Operations on 31. 12 NORTH BRANCH: North Branch, go. 13 OPERATIONS: Standby, West Branch. 14 Deputy ops qo --15 NORTH BRANCH: Say it again, North Branch. 16 OPERATIONS: Deputy ops, standby 1. West Branch from Operations on 31. 17 18 South Branch from Operations on 31. South Branch from 19 Operations on 31. OPERATIONS: Copy that, 1 1 5 0 Fairmont.

5 Communications, strike team at 1 1 5 0 Fairmont.

4

6 IC: Operations, IC. Operations, IC. 7 OPERATIONS: Go ahead to Operations.

8 IC: Okay. What I need you to do is let me know if the 9 resources that you're deploying right now and have on the inset 10 will suffice for the next two to three hours or are you looking at 11 additional needs in that timeframe?

OPERATIONS: Okay. I don't know what our resource is right now but I would like to have two strike teams in staging. We still have active, up on the north end, we still have a lot of homes up there on the north end. North Branch has not been relieved yet.

IC: Copy. I'll help you out on those two strike teams. IR I think they're being moved for you, but I'll double check on that. With the addition of those two strike teams, what does your next three hours look like? Are you good with that or do you need additional?

OPERATIONS: I think we're going to be okay with -- if we maintain two strike teams in staging. From what I've ordered right now, have two strike teams in staging, so we can start some rotations.

IC: All right. Copy. Hold off on any rotations for right now, until we get done having a discussion about how we're going to go forward. So I'll check to see that your two strike teams are being deployed through staging, and then we'll get back to you on what's left in staging, but based on two additional strike teams, you're good for the next three hours?

7 OPERATIONS: Yeah, two strike teams in staging after we 8 get these deployed is going to be a minimum. I'd like to see at 9 least three but I don't know how far we're getting out and how 10 soon they can get here, but three hours away, we've got to get 11 some of these crews rotated, at least the initial companies on.

IC: I copy. We'll put that together at the planning meeting. Until then, we'll make that work, and I'll get back to you on what your resources will be in staging after you get those two strike teams.

7 WILDLAND BRANCH: Par is all good here on the Wildland8 Branch.

9 OPERATIONS: Copy, you've got a par. Do you have your 10 units?

11 WILDLAND BRANCH: Yeah, affirmative. You want to run 12 down all my resources?

OPERATIONS: That's affirmative if you can do it.
 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, Communications, this is
 Code 3 traffic. Operations from Communications, Code 3 traffic.
 OPERATIONS: Go ahead to Operations.

17 COMMUNICATIONS: (indiscernible) requesting a medical
 18 (indiscernible) for an elderly patient, difficulty breathing at

20 OPERATIONS: Communications from Operations.

21 COMMUNICATIONS: Go ahead.

OPERATIONS: Apparently that is not in the fire. That's out of the fire. We have a resource command station to cover that.

25 COMMUNICATIONS: Copy. Not in the fire area. Refer

1 back to the Comm Center for regular operations.

2 OPERATIONS: 10-4.

WILDLAND BRANCH: Operations, Wildland Branch, whenyou're ready.

5 OPERATIONS: Okay, Wildland Branch, go ahead.

6 WILDLAND BRANCH: Okay. I have Strike Team 9160 7 Charlie. I don't have it broken down by engine, break. San Bruno 8 Taskforce 1 with the following engines, Engine 1663, Engine 1762, 9 Engine 1763, Engine 1764, Engine 1768, Engine 1769, Engine 1771 10 and Engine 3 1 7.

11 OPERATIONS: Copy that. We will not read those back to 12 you, but we believe we have all of them, and confirming right now, 13 you have all the resources you need and conditions in your area 14 are under control?

15 WILDLAND BRANCH: Well, I wouldn't say they're under 16 control, but we're making progress.

17 OPERATIONS: Copy that. You'll maintain all those18 units.

19 WILDLAND BRANCH: Affirmative. As soon as you can, and 20 I relayed this through Chief Talbert (ph.), any water tenders that 21 we could get would significantly improve our operations.

OPERATIONS: Copy that. Staging from Operations on 31.
 Traffic for Tanforan staging. Staging from Operations.

24 TANFORAN STAGING: Go ahead.

25 OPERATIONS: Do you have any water tenders in staging?

TANFORAN STAGING: Tanforan staging only has a fuel

3 OPERATIONS: IC from Operations on 31. IC from 4 Operations on 31. IC from Operations on 31. 5 MEDICAL GROUP: Ops, Medical Group. 6 IC: Operations, IC on Command. 7 OPERATIONS: IC, go ahead to Operations. IC: Did you have traffic: 8 9 OPERATIONS: I did. I was trying to get staging. 10 Staging is at Tanforan staging. We could use some more water 11 tenders if we have any availability. I know San Bruno Water 12 Department has a water tender but we could use a couple of more 13 water tenders if possible, if we can figure out from Logistics 14 where we can get that. 15 IC: Copy that. I'll see what we have on water tender 16 resources and then I'll get -- have you been contact with staging? 17 OPERATIONS: That's affirmative. I can contact staging 18 from here. 19 Okay.  COMMUNICATIONS: Report of a woman down at San Bruno
 Avenue and Crestview. Confirm that's in the operational area.
 OPERATIONS: Confirming San Bruno and what?

11 COMMUNICATIONS: San Bruno and Crestview.

12 OPERATIONS: Communications from Operations. Is that 13 Crestmoor or Crestview?

14 COMMUNICATIONS: I have Crestview and San Bruno.

15 OPERATIONS: That's not in the operational area.

16 North Branch from Operations on 31.

17 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations, you were covered. Repeat18 your traffic.

OPERATIONS: North Branch from Operations on 31. NorthBranch from Operations on 31.

21 SAFETY 8B: South Branch, Safety 8B Flinders.

22 SOUTH BRANCH: This is South Branch, go ahead.

23 SAFETY 8B: Yeah, Frank, can you let Ops know we have a 24 DOA at 1670 Claremont, right on the sidewalk, and we covered it 25 up.

1 SOUTH BRANCH: This is Chris. At 1670 Claremont?

2 SAFETY 8B: Copy that, 1670 Claremont.

3 SOUTH BRANCH: Copy that.

4 UNIDENTIFIED SPEAKER: Communications (indiscernible) on 5 Command 31.

6 SOUTH BRANCH: Ops from South Branch.

7 IC: Operations, IC, on Command.

8 OPERATIONS: IC, go ahead to Ops.

9 IC: We have placed an order for five water tenders and 10 we'll place some additional orders for resources for the next 11 operation or dayshift. I'm not sure what the detail will be for 12 those five water tenders, but we'll get back to you, break. 13 Additionally, do you have PG&E there with you and have you had a 14 conversation with them in terms of where they're at in shutting 15 down the gas line?

16 I copy your traffic on the five water OPERATIONS: 17 tenders. On PG&E, they were here initially, and they are not here 18 We did get confirmation when the fireball went out that gas now. 19 was shut down to the area. We do need to have PG&E, if you can 20 find a resource up there, and put them in the command post 21 somewhere up there. We want to get confirmation that all 22 electrical power has been shut down in the area. We have lines 23 all over the ground.

IC: Okay, copy. We have -- we will get PG&E to give us another update. They have completed the shutdown but there's

1 residual issues with the line, and I'll confirm on the power lines
2 for you.

3 OPERATIONS: Copy that. We did get confirmation. We 4 still have a little bit of gas going, but if you can get 5 confirmation on the power lines, at least they can start working 6 on them down there.

IC: Copy. One of the requests of PG&E earlier on was in order to get in, with all the power lines, they were going to need to have some support from our side in terms of getting in there. Is that possible or is it something they can get into now without needing fire resources to escort them in?

OPERATIONS: That's negative. They're not going to be able to get in without some type of escort. We can take care of that in briefing and come up with a plan to get them down to these divisions and branches.

16 IC: All right. Copy. We'll get with PG&E and ask them 17 about the power lines.

18 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations from Communications.

19 OPERATIONS: Operations, go.

20 COMMUNICATIONS: Can you provide the location for the 21 water shuttle?

22 SAFETY 8B: Ops, this is Safety 8B.

OPERATIONS: You want to confirm the location for thewater. I'm sorry. I didn't catch the rest.

25 COMMUNICATIONS: I need the location for the water

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1 shuttle to be dropped.

2 SAFETY 8B: Ops, Safety 8B.

3 OPERATIONS: Copy that. We would like that water that 4 we ordered I guess at the San Bruno Water to go to the Wildland 5 Branch. They'll go to Wildland Branch, and I'll get a location 6 for you.

7 SAFETY 8B: Ops, Safety 8B.

8 OPERATIONS: Safety 8B, go.

9 SAFETY 8B: Yeah, we have one engine, Engine 24 and a 10 Cal Fire Type 3 1684 at 1611 Claremont along with a battalion 11 chief from Cal Fire. We're going to take care of Claremont on the 12 east side of Fairmont.

13 COMMUNICATIONS: Ops from Communications.

14 OPERATIONS: Where are they working? Which branch? Are 15 they working under South Branch?

16 SAFETY 8B: I went through Frank on the South Branch to 17 tell them our needs, but he sort of just cruised around and he 18 found that nobody was here like we did. So we have a Type 1 and a 19 Type 3 here, but we could probably use another Type 1, and we have 20 a five inch supply line.

21 OPERATIONS: Copy that.

22 COMMUNICATIONS: Medical aid.

23 TANFORAN STAGING: Operations, Tanforan staging.

24 OPERATIONS: Operations.

25 TANFORAN STAGING: If you could pass it up the chain,

we're getting a lot of evacuees down here at Tanforan looking for
 a place to go, and also I'm getting more news media showing up
 here looking for a PIO.

4 COMMUNICATIONS: Communications, copy staging request.
5 I'll pass that on. Operations, I have a medical aid for you.
6 OPERATIONS: North Branch from Operations on 31.
7 NORTH BRANCH: This is North Branch, go ahead.
8 OPERATIONS: Did you get your strike teams?

9 NORTH BRANCH: I sure did. Thank you very much. Our 10 plan now, we've got one Type 1 strike team on Concord Avenue. 11 We're going to attempt to do some quick attacks on several homes 12 that are to the burn. We're going to try to make it stop. I have 13 one Charlie Type 3 strike team to Claremont and Concord into the 14 ravine to prevent any forward spread to some other structures that 15 were threatened and an additional Type 1 supporting them. All 16 strike teams are deployed on division for North Branch.

17 OPERATIONS: Copy that. Do you have any other resource 18 needs?

19 NORTH BRANCH: Not at this time. You can also log that 20 we have a solo resource Cal Fire 1 7 7 1. It's a Type 3 that is 21 now assigned to North Branch.

22 OPERATIONS: Confirming 1 7 7 3 to the North Branch.

23 NORTH BRANCH: That's 1 7 7 1.

24 OPERATIONS: Copy that, 1 7 7 1.

25 COMMUNICATIONS: Operations from Communications, medical

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1 aid.

OPERATIONS: Go ahead to Operations. COMMUNICATIONS: I have a medical aid, man down San Bruno and Glenview, San Bruno Avenue at Glenview. OPERATIONS: Copy that. We're going to see if medical can take care of that one. COMMUNICATIONS: Okay. And also Operations from Communications, I still need the water drop location for the water shuttle. OPERATIONS: Wildland Branch from Operations on 31. Wildland Branch from Operations on 31. (TALKING CLOCK: Ending date Thursday, September 9, 2010, at 21 hours 15 minutes and 13 seconds.)
