18:38 82B3 responded from WMC to scene with and and and but was initially given incorrect location and got on TSP NB and stuck momentarily in traffic

18:41 placed 82B2 at scene at TSP and Commerce in SB land and immediate met up with Medic 1 to begin scene safety and evaluate.

18:38 82B1 responded from WMC to scene with and coming thru Grasslands Rd to Legion Drive ,Columbus Ave ,Lakeview to Commerce locating ambulance on TSP SB . Immediately following Captain Marello went to end of train to assess and assist with triage and evacuation. established EMS IC at the location of 82B2.

Met with GPD assisting at site with EMS IC.

18:45 82B3 on location and left rig for transport and began triage.
