you might want to put a couple of servicemen out to check pressure on the Bay - I'm trying to give you a location on the Bay Bridge side of San Francisco maybe down around the airport whatever. Maybe check pressure a couple of places just to make sure pressure is holding up for you. But we've gone from 2 feeds to 1. You appear to be doing fine. The pressure appears to be holding fine. But just to be on safety precaution you might want to check.
