
I've done some more digging and I haven't been able to find a requirements letter for the operational HEMS tool. I circled back with the NWS and they don't have a formal requirement on file. We don't either. We do have a requirements letter for the CVA, which is the C&V information provided in the HEMS tool. It is attached. The only other documentation we have is what I've already sent you:

The attached document is the canceled FAA notice that gave the original guidance for the use of the experimental HEMS tool by HEMS pilots. I see the training/knowledge for users in AC 00-45H and description therein... but i didn't know where the HEMS Wx tool falls under a specific FAA requirement?

"Pursuant to Title 49 United States Code Section 44720, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) establishes requirements for the weather information and services necessary for the safe and efficient conduct of operations in the National Airspace System (NAS). As such, NOAA/NWS may be tasked to provide the weather information and services necessary to meet the requirements established by the FAA. **Operational implementation of the HEMS tool has been identified as an FAA requirement**."

The background info in these documents outside the above question is perfect. Again, i just want to make sure that when writing up the factual i reference the correct FAA requirement and NWS service change notice... Thank you!
