We climbed out on top within a few minutes after takeoff

Winds were favoring Runway 05 around 10kts

Before we switched to Indy Center, we heard Charleston approach clear aircraft for a VOR-A approach into KCRW. I briefly thought it was odd they weren't doing the LOC 05, but didn't think too much about it.
