

METEOROLOGICAL INFORMATION

At 1815, the Wittman Regional Airport (KOSH) automated weather observation system reported the following weather conditions: wind from 200 degrees true at 11 knots, gusting to 16 knots; visibility 9 miles; sky clear below 12,000 feet; temperature 29 degrees Celsius; dew point 23 degrees Celsius; altimeter 29.89 inches-of-mercury.

The weather observation station also recorded the following 1-minute wind data:

At 1813, wind from 198 degrees at 11 knots; peak wind from 190 degrees at 13 knots

At 1814, wind from 198 degrees at 11 knots; peak wind from 198 degrees at 16 knots

At 1815, wind from 196 degrees at 11 knots; peak wind from 205 degrees at 14 knots

At 1816, wind from 198 degrees at 10 knots; peak wind from 211 degrees at 13 knots

At 1817, wind from 197 degrees at 9 knots; peak wind from 201 degrees at 11 knots

At 1818, wind from 196 degrees at 9 knots; peak wind from 214 degrees at 14 knots
