Caller stated he was about 2300 feet off the departure end of the runway. Said he stopped to look at the a/c because it was moving extremely slow (70-75 knots) and only 75-100 feet AGL when the a/c went

over his head — which he considered "extremely low". Caller stated that was very unusually at that

distance. Caller stated the engine sounded normal and despite the slow speed the $\mbox{a/c}$ was not

"wobbling" left to right.
