SUBJECT Accident involving N8661S

Conducted an interview with Mr. Don Williams and his nephew Mr. Blake Williams. Both individuals directly observed the accident involving N8661S on 7/24/2017.			
Mr. Williams stated that approximately 17:00 on Sunday, 24 July 2017, he was watching TV and stepped outside to talk to his nephew (Mr. Blake Williams) who was fishing off a pier in Lake D'Arbonne. He heard and observed an aircraft making several low passes over the lake. He stated the aircraft had been circling and making the low passes for around 1 hour. On the last pass, the aircraft circled west of his house, and made a another low pass over the lake on a south to north heading. During this low pass, the aircraft was level at approximately 5-10 feet above the surface. The aircraft made a slight pitch up and then back down, with the left main gear and left wing contacting the water. The aircraft then cartwheeled, and came to rest in the water quickly.

Mr. Williams further stated the pilot was friends with a neighbor and had a history of low passes over the lake at this location for the past (about) 4 years.
