STATEMENT

I was on the Army Aviation Flight Line looking South and noticed a small single engine Land Fixed Wing airplane on his upwind leg. He was low in altitude, approximately 50'-75'. As the airplane turned cross-wind, ~~As the~~ It was visibly apparent that the pilot was struggling to fly the airplane and climb. NOTE. At the time, there was a building thunderstorm South of the plane, approximately 1 to 2 miles south. As the airplane was heading West, he was slowly climbing, at best. Approximately 200' after his ~~down~~ crosswind turn and the airplane APPEARED to stall. The right wing fell and the airplane yawed right and descended behind a dirt berm and ~~in~~ out of my line of sight.
