DET-INTERVIEW

Sir,

With reference to the report of an airplane crash on 10-24-2012, taken by PO Sean O'Malley DSN [REDACTED], the following is relative thereto:

On 10-24-2012, at 2050 hours, I was dispatched to the Creve Coeur Lake, near Sailboat Cove and the Tremayne Shelter for a report of an airplane crash. Upon arrival, I photographed the scene. I later uploaded those photographs to the images section of the 2012 PD Photo files, under this report number.

I interviewed the only known witness to the crash at 2128 hours on 10-24-2012. She was identified as one:

Dewey said that she was visiting the lake area and had parked her car adjacent to the boat ramp, which is on the northern section, on the north-east side of the lake. She said that she heard the engine of a plane overhead and it sounded like it was flying low. She looked for it in the sky and observed it approaching her position from the east. She said that the plane turned south and then east as it passed her location. She said that the motor sounded odd, like it was sputtering. The plane began to descend and Dewey said that it looked as though the pilot was trying to land along the shoreline. She said that as soon as the plane touched the water, it overturned, and began to sink. She said that it came to rest about 20 to 30 feet off the shoreline.
