Narrative:

The following is a summary of conversation with Dep Rakoczy of the Carbon County Sheriff's office. He was reporting from on-scene.

Dr Rakoczy reported that there was about a 100 yard debris path or ground scar leading up to the wreckage. The wreckage was oriented in a nose down/tail up position. There was no odor of fuel but signs that fuel had sloshed out of the right wing filler port. The pilot was male, seated in the left seat and a very large man. The passenger was a smaller female of Asian descent. There were two suit cases in the baggage compartment and a satchel type of flight bag.

The weather when he arrive on-scene was calm and clear. He hear a whirring or fan type noise coming from the cockpit. The noise was no longer present after the Coroner had removed the victims.

The following is a summary of conversation with Mr Kurt Jolley, the registered owner of the airplane, and a student pilot.

Mr Jolley stated that he had inherited the airplane from a relative. He had given his uncle (the pilot), who was a private pilot, permission to use the airplane over the summer.

Mr Jolley said that Saturday night (Sept 20) his uncle called him and left a message. The time of the message as shown in his mobile phone was 2203 pacific day light time since he was at his home in Everett, WA. In the message his uncle said that they were in Saratoga and were preflighting in the dark. Mr Jolley returned the phone call at 2231 PDT and the call went unanswered.

Driving North on CR 385 Southwest of Saratoga Airport. Observed vehicle towards airport out of place. Turned East on two track toward city water towers.

Could see was wrecked aircraft. Turned around and went to Saratoga P.D. Asked dispatcher about plane. Had been no report. Returned to site while she dispatched officer on duty. Approached plane on foot. Two hunters I stopped down on 385 on returned drove closer. I observed two people obviously dead in plane. Two hunters tried 911 no service. Saratoga PD was followed by hunters after went by. Waited for law enforcement to arrive.

Officer Lehr confirmed no survivors when he arrived. I continued to wait with Lehr until Deputy arrived.
