## Narrative:

On July 3, 2016, about 1753 Alaska daylight time, a Cessna 206 airplane, N6251K, sustained substantial damage after impacting trees during an aborted landing in the ocean waters of Halibut Cove, Alaska.

Six witnesses were interviewed and all provided a similar recollection of events. They observed the accident airplane approach for a landing on clam, glassy water. Following touchdown, the airplane became airborne again and climbed about 40ft toward nearby trees.

The left float contacted the trees, separated from the airplane and the airplane entered a steep descent until impact with the water.
