## Narrative:

Ms. Allen was approximately 400 yards west-northwest of the airstrip at the time of the accident. She observed most of the accident sequence; although, there were times that her line of sight was obstructed. She reported that the pilot took off and circled the local area before returning for a landing without incident. The pilot subsequently took off a second time and returned for a landing. She was unable to tell if the airplane touched down from her point of view; however, it started to climb once again. As it climbed, the airplane banked to the right momentarily, leveled its wings, and then as the it passed over a tree, banked right again. At that time, the right wing hit some tree branches causing the airplane to turn to the right and descend into the ground. She was unsure if the airplane would have cleared the tree without it banking to the right a second time.

Ms. Allen did not perceive any issues with the airplane during the time she saw it.	She recalled the
weather conditions as clear skies and a light wind with occasional gusts.
