Good morning gentlemen my name is Steve Hilling and I reside at [REDACTED] Conway Sc.

On the afternoon of August 3, 2013 approximately around 1:00 pm my wife and I were outside in our back yard enjoying our day off when we suddenly heard the sound of a airplane flying low. I was on the pool deck working on a gas grill and when I heard the plane I looked up and saw that the plane was extremely low . It appeared that it was coming from a west southwest direction.

Moments later I could hear the engine sputtering and stalling and at the same time I witnessed the plane banking toward the Southeast really hard, almost to the point I thought the plane was going to turn completely upside down. Then all of a sudden it sounded like the plane went to full power and it was like he was trying to get altitude but the plane was still rocking side to side like it was not in control. All I can remember after that point is the plane losing altitude and clipping the power lines with the left wing and hitting the ground then exploding.

If there is anything else you may need from me please let me know. I hope my information helps determine what happened so,the families may have some closure .

My name is Karen Hilling and I live at [REDACTED], Conway, SC 29527

With regard to the plane crash on August 3, 2013 that happened outside my home, this is what I saw:

I was in my pool, leaning up against the wall, facing the woods.

Heard the plane approaching and instantly knew something was not right. The plane was very close, too close. It came in to view and the plane appeared to be going in for a normal landing (except there is no runway here).

The plane was barely above the tree line and it was going down As I made my way to the ladder to exit the pool, I saw the plane barely clear a neighbors house

As I climbed the ladder and exited the pool, I heard the plane hit pole then crash to ground and saw it explode on impact. The power lines above were on fire and crackling

I did not see any landing gear exposed. The nose of the plane was down

At no time did I witness any attempt to pull up and out of the rapid decent I do remember hearing lots of sputtering/choking

This whole thing happened in the span of maybe 7-10 seconds from the time I heard to the time it crashed
