PRIORS: geo911 Inc

On 03-24-14 Glynn County Police received a call in reference to a plane possibly crashing in the area of Marshes of McKay. I responded to the area of Mackqueen Dr. and made contact with Valerie Whitehead. She stated she heard and then saw a plane flying very low. Ms. Whitehead also said she heard a "thud" shortly after losing sight of the plane. Ms. Whitehead indicated the plane was flying in a northeasterly direction and this is the direction she heard the "thud".

I then went to the area of Palm Island Rd. and made contact with Bob Amerson. He stated he was at his residence and an airplane flying along the marsh behind his residence. He said he heard the plane sputter 2 or 3 times and then heard what he thought was an explosion. Bob stated a few

seconds later he heard a crashing sound. He said he drove to the end of Palm Island Rd. at the marsh. Bob said he got out of his vehicle and he saw approximately 6-8 pieces of debris floating down. He stated he never saw the plane nor did he see any smoke or fire. Bob escorted me to the end of Palm Island Rd. where he saw the debris falling. The area he showed me where the debris was falling was out over the marsh. The direction he showed me was east and slightly south of the end of Palm Island Rd. Bob said he thought the 2nd noise he heard, what he believed to be the plane crashing, is in a northeast direction from the end of Palm Island Rd.

I notified Chief Doering of the situation and he notified Capt. Wiggins with EMA. DNR. Georgia State Patrol, Coast Guard, and civil air patrol responded to the area. DNR put boats in the water and responded to the area of Grant Creek which runs behind Marshes of McKay. I was advised that civil air patrol found some debris in the marsh and DNR personnel were able to locate it. DNR marked the coordinates of this debris. The Coast Guard helicopter responded to the area to assist in the search. At this time, it is unknown if Coast Guard was able to locate any debris.

At approximately 2230 hrs., the search was suspended until 0700 hrs. on 03-25-14. This report will be completed when more details are known.
