A party may also propose safety recommendations for preventive action.¹ All submissions should be made in writing and parties should serve copies of submissions on all other parties.’ Any submissions must be submitted to the other parties and the Investigator-in-Charge (IIC) by Monday September 26th, 2022.

Please remember that draft Factual Reports are for official-use-only until released in the public docket, and NTSB regulations prohibit the release of investigative information that has not been released by the NTSB without prior consultation and approval of the IIC.
