The NTSB investigative team will review all comments and provide the parties with a written summary of the disposition of those comments, including whether any changes will be made to the reports. Please remember that the draft reports are for official use only and United States Code § 49 part 831.13 prohibits the release of investigative information that has not been released by the NTSB without prior consultation and approval of the Investigator-In-Charge.

You will receive the documents to be reviewed via the NTSB's secure file sharing service. The documents will be in PDF format and consist of a Factual Report of Investigation and (12) supporting attachments.
