The City of Delray Beach and the State of Florida is establishing a new 24-hour Quiet Zone on the FEC Railway effective June 2, 2018.

This Quiet Zone is established under the authority of 49 CFR §222.39(a)(3).

A Notice of Intent (NOI), approved by the City of Delray Beach Commission, was executed on February 16, 2016 and no comments were received from any applicable parties.
