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It is 2:11. MR. CURRIE: It's 1 p.m. and we are at the residence of Laura Aicob in in Delray Beach, in

5 reference to case HWY23MH006.

My name is Shawn, S-h-a-w-n, Currie, C-u-r-r-i-e. I'm an investigator with the National Transportation Safety Board, Office of Highway Safety. And speaking to Laura.

#### INTERVIEW OF LAURA AICOB

### BY MR. CURRIE:

- 11 Laura, can you say and spell your name for me, please?
- 12 My name is Laura, L-a-u-r-a, and -- Laura Aicob. Aicob is A-13 i-c-o-b.
- 14 And you called the police and said you were a witness? Okav.
- 15 Yes.
- 16 Can you tell me what you saw, please?
- 17 I was stopped in east Lindell Boulevard on the intersection
- 18 with Dixie Highway, waiting for a green light. And in that moment
- 19 from, not Dixie where already have green, one of the car --
- 20 normally two cars came, one behind the other one. Where first
- 21 car, when got in the intersection Lindell with Dixie, the car took
- 22 a right, which is Lindell Boulevard west. And right away when she
- 23 was -- I can say in a 90 degree with the Dixie Highway, start the
- 24 But before she got in Dixie Highway, the flashing lights
- 25 from the train was on and the barrier start to came down.

In the same time when the car took right on the -- on Lindell Boulevard and then stopped. Stayed there until the first train from south came north, and then somebody came out from the passenger seat, was a lady. Came out from the car, very calm, very -- didn't look like she's panicked or screaming or something else, no. Looks like she was talking with the driver and then went little bit to the car, speaking, I think, was -- looks like was speaking with the driver, and then she changed her mind and then got back in the car.

10 Q. Okay.

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- A. And closed the door. And then few seconds later, the train from north came and hit them. And when they hit them, the twirled (ph.) them around. And first time turn in the circle and then turned over and throw them on the -- between Dixie Highway and the grass. The (indiscernible) grass there, it was -- more than that,
- 17 | O. Mm-hmm.
- 18 | A. I couldn't.
- 19 Q. Okay. So you saw the car come -- the -- what color -- do you
- 20 | know what color the car was?
- A. I cannot say was white. I cannot say that was this green that I have in the house. I cannot say that was yellow. But was a very light color.
- 24 | Q. Okay. And you saw it turn from Dixie onto --

I was not there to see because I was shaking.

25 A. Yes.

- Q. -- Lindell?
- 2 | A. Yes.

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- 3 Q. Did it have its headlights on?
- $4 \parallel A$ . I don't know.
- 5 Q. Okay. But you saw it turn and stop?
- 6 A. Yes. She came -- was driving and then right away stopped
- 7 | before -- before to pass the track line.
- 8 0. Okay.
- 9 A. Yeah. She stopped there.
- 10 | Q. And you were coming from Lindell and you were gonna take a
- 11 | right?
- 12 | A. No.
- 13 | Q. You were going to go straight?
- 14 | A. Yes.
- 15 | Q. Is that a way to come here back -- the back way?
- 16 A. Yes, yeah.
- 17 Q. Okay. And so this all was in front of you.
- 18 A. Exactly.
- 19 Q. So you didn't have to turn your head. You saw it all.
- 20 A. No, no, no. It was exactly in front of me. You know, how is
- 21 the intersection in a cross.
- 22 | Q. Yes.
- 23 A. I was here in east Lindell Boulevard and they came from here
- 24 | from north. North Dixie Highway.
- 25 Q. Okay. So they stopped, then the lights came on? Or the

- lights were on when they --
- 2  $\mid A$ . The lights -- the flashing lights from the train was on. And
- $3 \parallel$  in the same time when they did right, the gate start to come out.
- $4 \mid \mid$  And I think they didn't see the gate. And then when they did --
- 5 when already turned in a 40 -- in a 90 degree, they saw the second
- 6 gate and they stopped there.
- 7 Q. Okay. And then when you were -- you could -- could you see
- 8 their brake lights, or any lights?
- 9 A. Yes, yeah. You can see -- because it was -- was dark. First
- 10 | thing (ph.) was around 8:00. Was around 8:00, was dark.
- 11 | Q. Okay.
- 12 A. But could be confused because I had red.
- 13 | Q. Okay.
- $14 \mid A$ . And I was waiting for green. And was my red from stop lights
- 15 and the same time came the red from the --
- 16 | Q. Okay.
- 17 A. -- from the train.
- 18  $\parallel$  Q. And you saw the lady get out of the car?
- 19 A. Yes, I saw.
- 20 Q. And what did she -- did she look around, or?
- 21 A. No, no. She came out from the car, opened the car, opened
- 22 | the door, came out from the car, bend a little bit like, was she
- 23 | talking with the driver, and then she came back.
- 24 | Q. Huh.
- 25 A. No screaming, no show that she's scared, no show nothing.

- Q. About how long do you think they were parked there?
- $2 \mid A$ . Like, a few minutes. Two minutes.
- 3 **1** 0. So --

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- 4 A. Two minutes, three. Two minutes because it was very fast
- 5 | between trains. The time where she could get out from the car was
- 6 | before the train came. Even me, to be honest, I didn't expect to
- 7 be both trains.
- 8 0. Okay.
- 9 A. You know? But when she stopped there, she -- when the car
- 10 stopped there, they had time. They had time to get out from the
- 11 car because I remember the train from south, how you say,
- 12 (indiscernible) -- beep beep.
- 13 | Q. Bells?
- 14  $\mid A$ . No, not the bells, no.
- 15 | O. Whistle?
- 16 A. Um, the ring. The ring.
- 17 Q. Oh, ring?
- 18 A. No, the noise. The noise where the train do.
- 19 Q. Oh, clang, clang, clang, clang, clang?
- 20 | A. No.
- 21 | O. Whistle?
- 22 | A. It's okay.
- 23 (Laughter)
- 24 Q. You can say it in Romanian.
- 25 A. (Indiscernible). When the --

Q. Horn.

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- 2 A. Horn.
- 3 | Q. Okay.
- 4 A. (Indiscernible) the horn, yes. When the train horn --
- 5 | because the first thing came slowly, then the bright lights. And
- 6 the first train start to horn very far away, you know? And they
- 7 didn't get maybe -- I don't know. Didn't get out. And then few
- 8 seconds later, the bright lights came.
- 9 0. Okay.
- 10 A. And hit them.
- 11 | Q. Now, did your vehicle get damaged at all?
- 12 A. No, no.
- 13 Q. Okay. And you left. You didn't stay, you left? You came
- 14 | home?
- 15 A. I didn't left right away because I couldn't. I was in a
- $16 \parallel$  shock and my body was shaking and I was scared to drive. And I
- 17 pulled on the grass. I pulled the car on the grass and I stayed
- 18 | there like, 10 minutes, 15 minutes. And I know the police was
- 19 there, a lot of police, and then they asked us to leave.
- 20 | Q. Okay.
- 21 A. From that area.
- 22 | Q. Okay. Is there anything that I forgot to ask you? Anything
- 23 you can -- else you can remember, or is that pretty much it?
- 24 A. No. I think that is.
- 25 MR. CURRIE: Okay. Okay, well, thank you for your time, and
