Narrative:

The Harris County Hazardous Materials Response Team (HCHMRT) was requested to assist the HCFMO Arson with a vehicle fire resulting from a single car motor vehicle accident. Upon arrival, we met with the HCFMO Arson unit for a situational briefing and then conducted an on scene hazard and risk assessment, at which time the fire had been extinguished by the Woodlands Fire Department prior to HCHMRT arrival. HCHMRT noted no immediate hazards present and assisted the Harris County Medical Examiners Office in acquiring pictures of the victims in the burnt vehicle, no other services needed. HCHMRT returned to service
