4507, 3424 Nestler 4821, 3425 LaBella 4203, 3427 Faith 3012, 3428 Wilson 4554, 3429 Llewellyn 4443 responded to the bridge (Fern Hollow Bridge) at the intersection of S Braddock/Forbes Ave for a bridge collapse.

Upon arrival I observed one of the victims, later identified per a 911 call as Jerney Habwoski, walking inbound on Forbes Ave. Officers asked Habwoski if he was okay and he kept walking. At approximately 0813 hours, Officers made contact with Habowski a [REDACTED] and denied injury and denied EMS. When Officers were closer to the bridge, it was determined there was a black BMW SDN, bearing PA Registration [REDACTED] inches away from falling over the hill. The driver (Felicia Pitek-Smith) and her son were outside the vehicle and not injured. The vehicle was later towed from the scene by McGann and Chester. Officers left a voice mail for Pitek-Smith to inform her where her vehicle was. I will be attempting to make contact with her once more and provide her a CCR number.

Officers smelled a strong odor of gas and heard a loud roaring sound coming from the bridge due to the gas line along the bridge that had ruptured. I observed multiple vehicles on the bridge down below. There were a total of 5 vehicles along with one Port Authority Bus (3309) on the collapsed roadway. Officer Henry, Franks, Salerno, Nestler, LaBella immediately rushed down the hillside to render aid/evacuate the victims. Officers were able to get all the victims out of their vehicles and all the victims sustained minor injuries. There were no casualties to be reported.

The red Ford F-150 was occupied by the driver and passenger and were safely evacuated by Officers. I was unable to gather any further information for the other vehicles involved. Officers will be completing supplements with further victim and witness information that they had gathered during the day.

All victims on scene were advised to contact Zone 4 Police Station for the report number.

The gas company was notified at approximately 0645 hours. Homes in the area were evacuated by the fire department. The gas line was shut off at approximately 0728 hours.

Duquesne Light was notified at approximately 0649 hours.

Hazmat truck, MCU, and MCI notified at approximately 0655 hours.

PSP arrived on scene at approximately 0742 with a drone to sweep the area. At 0812 hours a thermal sweep was conducted.

TAC units arrived on scene to assist with the search.

Incident command was turned over to police at 0849 hours.

Verizon arrived on scene at approximately 1058 hours.

<p>On 1/28/2022 at approximately 0630 hours, I responded near Forbes Ave. and S. Braddock Ave. for a report of a bridge collapse (Fern Hollow Bridge). I responded along with multiple other Zone 4 officers. While in route dispatch advised us that vehicles had potentially fallen with the bridge and multiple people could be heard screaming by the call taker with static in the background.</p> <p>Upon arrival, I heard an incredibly loud roaring noise and smelled natural gas. The noise was so loud that I could not hear my radio throughout this incident at full volume. I also observed a black BMW (PA REG: [REDACTED]) stopped within inches before the collapsed bridge. At this time I made contact with a Felicia Pitek-Smith and her Juvenile son (approximately 4-5 years old). They were standing near her vehicle on the sidewalk on Forbes Ave. At this time I had them get into the front seat of my police vehicle. Pitek-Smith explained that she barely avoided driving over the edge of the now missing bridge. They were not injured and advised me that no one else was in the car.</p> <p>At this time, Officer Banker placed Pitek-Smith and her young son into her vehicle while I walked down Forbes Ave. to observe the collapsed bridge. From above I could see multiple cars crashed in the ravine and an articulated Port Authority Bus. I could see headlights of multiple crashed vehicles below as it was still dark outside at this time.</p> <p>Ultimately, I observed a driver of one of the vehicles make his way up through the woods and onto Forbes Avenue. At this time I decided to go on foot down through the woods with Officer Labella, Nestler, Henry and Franks. It took us approximately 3-4 minutes and a quarter mile to make it down the steep and snowy hillside in order to access the vehicles at the bottom of the ravine.</p> <p>Upon arriving at the lowest point of the collapsed bridge, I observed one of the vehicle driver's standing up on the bridge. I later identified him as Tom Bench. Bench assisted me up onto the bridge and informed me he was not injured. Bench later stated that he thought at first he had a flat tire but then saw the Port Authority bus in front of him go up into the air. It was at this time that he realized the bridge was collapsing and he thought his vehicle was going to be crushed by the Port Authority Bus. However, Bench's Subaru Outback slid down the collapsed bridge.</p> <p>Once on the bridge I attempted to check 3 vehicles for victims. Upon checking a maroon Ford F-150 (unknown plate) I observed an elderly male standing outside of it and an elderly female still inside in the front passenger seat. All vehicles including the truck sustained heavy damage. I pried the passenger door open and told the female that she needed to get out and come with me. The female stated she couldn't and was shaking her head no. I asked her what hurt. She stated her back hurt. This female and male were later identified as Velva Perry and Tyrone Perry respectively. Due to the intense odor and noise of natural gas and the possibility of shifting pieces of bridge, I was able to help Velva out of the truck. With Officer Henry's assistance we slowly walked her to the end of the bridge. At this time I lowered Velva approximately 4-5 feet to Tom Bench waiting below who grabbed her legs and further lowered her down. Officer Henry, Franks and Nestler assisted with getting Tyrone Perry down as he was elderly and walking with a cane.</p> <p>Ultimately Velva and Tyrone Perry were walked to a nearby park bench. At this time I went back onto the collapsed bridge to double check various crashed vehicles for victims with negative results. I then returned to where Velva and Tyrone Perry were. At this time Officer Labella and I believed we were still too close to the collapsed bridge and decided to carry Velva approximately 100 yards away to a bench further away from the scene. I carried Velva's upper body while Labella carried her by her legs.</p>

It was at this park bench that Velva and Tyrone Perry received further medical care . (cervical collar, thermal blanket and IV fluids) Velva was placed on a board and placed in the rear of a Black Ram truck that arrived on scene (driven by Atkinson). Tom Bench rode back up in Atkinson's front seat in order to get a ride home to Bethel Park. I advised both Bench and Tyrone Perry that their cars would most likely be towed by McGann and Chester but that it could take days. I provided them my contact information and information for McGann and Chester. Officer Labella, Franks and I were driven back up in UTV's by public works.

My body worn camera was activated throughout this incident. It should be noted that while carrying Velva Perry it fell off and briefly stopped recording. I was able to find it and press record again so there are two separate lengthy recordings from this incident.

I was unable to get plate information for the Perry's or Bench's vehicles.
