

Job descriptions:

Captain

The captain is in overall command of the vessel and is responsible for the safety of the vessel, crew, and passengers. The captain has the overriding authority to take additional precautions that exceed or deviate from the SMS requirements with respect to the safety of the vessel and its crew, or the protection of the environment.

The captain reports to the Vice President Operations on all operational issues and maintains an open line of communications with the DPA regarding safety Management issues.

The Captain is the Vessel Security Officer.

The Captain is responsible for implementing Seastreak policies and procedures aboard the vessel, giving clear direction, verifying compliance to the FSMS requirements and reporting FSMS deficiencies.

Mate

The Mate reports directly to the vessel Captain and oversees the safety of passenger embarking and disembarking operations, assists in navigation of the vessel, firefighting and lifesaving equipment readiness and other duties as assigned.

The Mate is responsible for implementing Seastreak Policies and procedural requirement onboard as relating to his/her position.
