






Distraction









Reaction Time about 35 feet in 3/4 second.

At 65mph you will travel about 70 feet.

Following Distance

- 3 second rule
- Add one second for each additional hazard
 - Slippery roadsPoor visibilityHeavy Traffic



Duties of a Driver

- Maintain a reasonable lookout
- Maintain control of the vehicle
- Obey all traffic laws, signs etc.
