Per our conversation, on October 13, 2017 Mr. Edney reportedly encountered a gust of wind during landing and was unable to maintain directional control. He veered off the side of the runway and landed in the grass area. As he did so, the aircraft struck a couple of landing lights, resulting in damage. There was damage to the leading edge and underside of the RH wing and TKS panel, as well as the RH horizontal and TKS panel. There was also apparently some minor damage on the left wing.
