<b>Narrative:</b> E-12 was dispatched to an MVC with Med 1 and S-1, and responded emergency traffic from the station. Upon arrival on school bus was found off the road sitting upright with heavy damage. The bus appeared to have lost control, and rolled at least twice. E-12 established command. EMS 1 had EMS command. E-12 secured the vehicle while medics began patient care. E-12 cut battery cables, and made sure the bus had breaks locked. E-12 assisted packaging the patient's, and extricating them from the bus. E-12 secured the roadway to allow air medical to land. E-12 remained on location to control traffic. One of E-12 crew members had an exposure, and it was documented and recorded. DPS advised they no longer needed traffic control. Command was terminated, and E-12 returned to service.
