The deadline for submitting your agency's collected comments to the NTSB is Friday November 4, 2022. Comments should be uploaded into the appropriate subfolder under the 'Technical Review Comments' folder in Kiteworks. The NTSB investigative team will review all comments and provide all parties with a written

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summary of the disposition of those comments, including what changes have been made to the reports or attachments.

The draft factual report and attachments are for official use only until released via the public docket. NTSB regulations prohibit the public release of investigative information without the approval of the Investigator-in-Charge.

Later in the process, you will have an opportunity to make a party submission in which you may offer your analysis, including conclusions, probable cause, and recommendations. Additional information on this process, including the deadline for submissions, will be sent at a later date.
