## **Narrative:**

The following are verbatim extracts of email communications between Ms. Morgan and the NTSB on the dates noted:

## July 23, 2020

NTSB questions (in black) re witness January 19, 2019 email statements (in black), and witness responses (in purple)

On the 4th line you state that a txt at 1001 shows the airplane as airborne

Do you know where that takeoff was from? <u>Meadview runway</u>, <u>Meadview AZ</u>

On the 5<sup>th</sup> line, you state that around 1038 Heidi called your nephew

Do you know where she was at that time? Was she airborne, or on the ground at Kingman? <u>My</u>
 <u>sister was on the ground in Kingman</u>, <u>AZ she told him they had gotten or attempted to
 <u>get fuel</u>.
</u>

Also on the 5th line you say "they departed Kingman"

- Who are "they" <u>They are Anderson and my Sister</u>
- Can you explain this 1038 reference to being in Kingman relative to the 1001 takeoff (from somewhere) <u>Anderson and my sister originally departed from Meadview AZ</u> <u>headed to Kingman AZ for fuel then on to the Mesa AZ area to meet us.</u>
- Can you explain this 1038 reference to being in Kingman relative to the "they departed Kingman" in the same sentence? <u>Anderson and my sister landed in Kingman AZ, my sister called my nephew from the ground in Kingman right before Anderson and my sister departed.</u>

## January 19, 2019

Email from witness to NTSB several days after the accident:

Thank you again for all of your help.

Time line as far as we know is as follows:

Chris [Anderson] and my sister [passenger] were at the bar until around 1-1:30 am, Sunday 1/13

I received a text message at 10:01 telling me she was in the air.

Around 10:38 my sister called my nephew from Kingman AZ. They departed Kingman headed for Glendale.
