MR. KAMINSKI: Hello, Ronald Kaminski, Safety Board.

MS. MCGRATH: Hi there. This is Ariel McGrath returning your call. You had just left me a voicemail.

MR. KAMINSKI: Yes, ma'am. Thank you so much for calling.
So, as I said, my name is Ronald Kaminski. I'm with the National
Transportation Safety Board and there's several of us in town
investigating this crash that occurred that on Sunday I guess you
witnessed, and I guess I'm just calling to get a statement from
you again as to what you saw on Sunday; Sunday morning?

MS. MCGRATH: Sure, I can definitely provide that.

MR. KAMINSKI: Okay, and would you mind if recorded your conversation, so I don't have to interrupt you?

MS. MCGRATH: No, that's totally fine.

INTERVIEW OF ARIEL MCGRATH

BY MR. KAMINSKI:

- Q. Great, thank you very much. So, why don't you start with, how do you spell your name? Let's get your name spelled correctly.
- 20 A. Sure, Ariel McGrath, A-r-i-e-l M-c-G-r-a-t-h.
- 21 Q. And this is a good phone number for you?
- 22 A. Yes, the
- Q. Okay, and why don't you just describe what you were doing and what you saw?
 - A. Sure, the reason I was on 95 that early in the morning, there

was the event; the Bike to the Beach from Philadelphia to Atlantic City. So, we had went down early that morning to drop my husband off down there to meet at the bridge and I was on 95 northbound coming home. And I was getting off at the Continent (phonetic) exit, again, I'm 95 northbound, and I was all the way to the right and I was, it's a pretty big exit, but by almost at the point where it actually splits from 95, I had seen the truck. I don't know if it lost control or flipped a little or what, but I saw the truck like right underneath the 95 overpass. I saw it, I think hit the wall, and a bunch of dirt come up, kind of rise above it, so, I could tell it lost control, or flipped or hit something, so I didn't want to get stuck behind that, so I went to get right back over onto 95 and that was when it just erupted, like completely exploded, huge ball of fire. When I drove by it, like I could feel the heat in my car. It just completely exploded. I think it happened between the time I saw it lose control and hit and the dirt fly up and the explosion may have been a few seconds. Okay, so, you were back what at the stop light then, would

- A. So, I wasn't at the stop light. I was still on 95 and I was about to get onto the off ramp, so like right where it actually starts to split and go down to the off ramp.
- 23 Q. Okay, got it.

you say?

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- 24 A. I was still able to get back on 95.
 - Q. Okay, and then -- so, did you see it sliding or you -- or you

- just saw this dust fly up?
- 2 A. I saw it like hit, like it rumbled, so it looked like it slid
- 3 or rolled a little bit, but I saw it hit the side and that's when
- $4 \parallel \text{I}$ saw the dirt come up too, so I don't know how that happened, I
- 5 just know it lost control at some point.
- $6 \parallel Q$. So, you saw it hit the sidewall of the underpass?
- 7 | A. Yes.
- 8 Q. Okay, and then it -- and then you saw it flip over on its
- 9 | side?

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- 10 A. No, it didn't completely flip over, that's what I kind of
- 11 considered like it starting to flip, like I didn't see it go all
- 12 | the way over on its side. I just saw it kind of tip over a little
- 13 bit, hit the wall.
- 14 | Q. Because you kept on driving and you need to keep your eyes on
- 15 | the road, I imagine?
- 16 **|** A. Yes.
- 17 | Q. Okay. And then it was pretty much instantaneous you said
- 18 | with the fire?
- 19 A. Yes. I want to say by the time I saw it hit and then the
- 20 explosion it may have a few seconds.
- 21 | Q. Had you noticed the truck before the exit?
- 22 | A. I did not, honestly. I just -- I happened to see it when it
- 23 was, you know, going down the off ramp, but I don't really have a
- 24 | recollection of what it may have been doing ahead of time.
- 25 \parallel Q. Did he look like he was going at highway speeds or was he,

did you see any brake lights?

- A. I really don't recall. I know I was in not really much
 traffic in the morning, so I was driving pretty fast, but I don't

 -- I can't say how fast he was going. I really just noticed it
- 5 once it hit the wall.
- Q. Okay. Well, this is my phone number if you think of anything else or that you think would be of interest, feel free to give me a call, and I appreciate you taking the time to give me a call back.
- A. Yeah, no problem. And I didn't see any other cars around it, like there were no other cars in front of me, like I think I was probably the closest car to it.
- 13 | Q. Okay.

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- A. So, I think there was, at least from my vantage point, I didn't see anybody else go down the off ramp in front of me between me and the truck. So, I believe it was just isolated to the truck's accident.
 - Q. Yeah, and that's what's come out. It was just a single vehicle, just a truck there, so. Okay, well again, I thank you very much for taking the time to give me a call.
- 21 A. Sure, no problem.
- 22 | Q. Thank you, take care.
- 23 A. You too, bye bye.
- 24 Q. Buh bye.
- 25 (Whereupon, the interview was concluded.)
