The above identified magneto was inspected and tested in accordance with TCM Form # X42003-2 July 2010.

The contacts were found synchronized within a degree of each other. The "E" gap was slightly retarded from its initial setting which is a result of normal cam follower wear.

The magneto was heated to 150 Degree F and run to 3000 RPM and 10mm gaps. The contacts were quiet with normal slight sparking. The impulse coupling was functional (no broken spring).

The magneto functioned normally with no faults found.
