Passenger Evacuation Checklist



Passenger Evacuation

This procedure contains the steps required to prepare for passenger evacuation on land and is initiated when a condition potentially endangering life or physical well-being of passengers and crew exists.

- Pilot:**
- (1) PARKING BRAKE ON
 - (2) EvacuationCOMMAND
 - (3) GND LIFT DUMPINGMAN DISARM
 - (4) Thrust leversSHUT OFF
 - (5) Evacuation INITIATE using PA system
 - (6) APU, LH ENG and RH ENG FIRE
PUSHSELECT
 - (7) BATTERY MASTER OFF

- Copilot: On evacuation command**
- (8) Air Traffic ControlNOTIFY of emergency conditions and intent to evacuate
- NOTE**
If ditching, disregard step (9).
- (9) EMER DEPRESS ON
 - (10) EMER LTS (coincident with PA) ON

Effectivity:

- Applicable to aircraft certified by IAC Aviation Register <AR>

NOTE

Prior to exiting the airplane, the portable ELT / emergency radio must be taken and kept by a crew member. Operate ELT / emergency radio according to the instructions attached.

- (11) Appropriate exits OPEN
- (12) Passenger evacuation ASSIST and DIRECT passengers away from the airplane

exit
