Narrative:

Sam Soloy was the Vice President of Soloy Helicopters. Operations and Human Performance Group Chairmen met with Mr. Soloy on July 7, 2021 at the company base of operations in Wasilla, Alaska.

Mr. Soloy stated during the meeting that Soloy Helicopters had not implemented any changes since the accident. He said he felt Soloy gave the accident pilot absolutely everything for success.

When asked if the FAA had visited Soloy since the accident, he initially said no, but then stated that the new POI had met with the director of operations and chief pilot for check airmen observations.

With regards to flight locating, Mr. Soloy said that although the accident flight departed from the Wasilla base, to keep standard operating procedure, the flight locating was being handled through TML.

Rob Gideon was the Chief Pilot of Soloy Helicopters. The Operations Group Chairman contacted Mr. Gideon on February 1 via telephone with permission of the Soloy Vice President for a follow-up question to the interviews conducted in April 2021.

Mr. Gideon was asked if he recalled meeting with the former FAA POI on May 28, 2021, or anytime towards the end of May to discuss flight locating or operational control. He stated that she went to Soloy Helicopters in Wasilla, but the purpose of the visit was to introduce the new POI who was there for check airmen observations. He stated that there were no discussions regarding operational control or flight locating.
