FIU is requesting FDOT and FHWA concurrence with the selection and contract negotiation process with Bolton Perez and Associates for the Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) services on the TIGER UniversityCity Prosperity Project.

On January 26, 2016, three applications for CEI services were received and these were evaluated in accordance with Florida Statutes 287.055. The Certification/Selection Committee members--John Cal (FIU), Alberto Delgado (FIU), Eric Gomez (City of Sweetwater) and Barbara Espino (FDOT)--met on February 25, 2016 to review and evaluate applicant qualifications, and all three firms were found to be qualified and invited to present and be interviewed. CEI Presentations/Interviews and Public Selection Committee Deliberations occurred on April 12, 2016 and this resulted in a ranking order as follows:

- 1. Bolton Perez & Associates (BPA)
- 2. Atkins North America
- 3. Metric Engineering

FDOT District Six concurred with this ranking on April 28, 2016. An initial negotiation meeting with FDOT, FIU and BPA was held on May 13, 2016 and subsequent negotiation meetings were held on May 31, June 15 and August 4. Attendance sign-in sheets, notes and meeting agenda of the negotiations are included with this request.

Also included with this request for concurrence is the proposed FIU Standard Professional Services Agreement, the Standard Professional Services Agreement Terms, Construction Engineering and Inspection Scope of Services (CEI Comprehensive Scope of Services), an Amendment to Standard Professional Services Agreement Scope of Services and the agreed-upon Method of Compensation and Price Proposal.

FIU is requesting FDOT and FHWA concurrence with the ranking of the Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) firm for the TIGER UniversityCity Prosperity Project.

On April 12, 2016, the three short-listed CEI firms (Bolton Perez & Associates, Atkins and Metric Engineering) presented their proposals before the selection committee. The committee members were:

Barbara Espino, District Construction Manager & Construction LAP Coordinator FDOT District Six

Eric Gomez, City Engineer, City of Sweetwater

Alberto Delgado, Asst. Director of Construction, FIU Facilities Management

John Cal, Associate Vice-President FIU Facilities Management

Each firm had the opportunity to present, followed by a question and answer period with the selection committee. The committee deliberated in open session and each member ranked each firm according to the approved scoring categories of "Understanding of the Program and Project Requirements," "Program and Approach and Method" and "Ability to Provide Service." The results of the scoring ranked Bolton Perez & Associates as the highest, followed by Atkins and Metric Engineering.

On the basis of the recommendation of the committee, I have concurred with the final ranking order of the CEI firms for the project. FIU President Mark B. Rosenberg has also approved the ranking. Upon concurrence by FDOT and FHWA, the notice of intent to award can be posted.

FIU allows a 72-hour period for protest following this public announcement and if there are no formal protests, the ranking will then be considered official. Additionally, FIU understands that FDOT must also approve the FIU independent staff hour estimate of for CEI services prior to beginning fee negotiations.




