## **NTSB Information Request**

Consolidated Edison, provide response to the following questions:

1. Do Consolidated Edison had in place a computer database to track all employees' operator qualifications records before the accident. If so what is the system called, and its configurations.

Response: Yes. Con Edison's training database/learning management system, which is called "eTrain," has been in place since 2010. The system is used to track the following information by individual: required and scheduled training; completed course descriptions; training completion dates; qualification periods; and re-qualification due dates. Con Edison also uses this system to query training data and generate reports. An earlier version of the training database/learning management system, called "The Registration System" (TRS), was used from the mid-1990's to 2010. Data from TRS was migrated into eTrain.

2. If Consolidated Edison does not have a computer database in place to track all employees' operator qualifications records before the accident; has any database been set up, if not, what plans has Con Edison to develop the system.

Response: N/A – see response to question 1.

3. Does Consolidated Edison have a person or group assigned the function to monitor operator qualifications record database of all employees if any.

<u>Response:</u> Yes. Con Edison's Gas Training Group uses the eTrain database to monitor operator qualifications for Gas Operations employees.
