He entered on the down wind between me and another Cesna 150 who appeared to be Significantly Slower than him. when he entered on the downwind I was just about to turn crosswind when the other Cessna 150 had just turned down wind. When him and the other cessna 150 turned based he extended this downwind to create seperation.

On his base to final turn he ologleged to allign with the runway. While turning final he overshot the runway i nereased his bank angle and pitched up slightly. Soon (within seconds) after he hit the ground, there was a puff of white smoke and within seconds after the white smoke a huge fire ball and black Smoke. Bight after he hit the ground the plane was upside down.
While he was flying he made all proper radio carls including the final turn, without any mention of malfunction.
