motors stopped sliding, we called and Emergency, dialed
up K-Line 911 and then had to crawl out on the
Conductor's side window. After a while Emergency
Services showed up, then BNSF people showed up,
then Conductor and myself went to ER to get
checked out. Then to Quincy then wrote this then
went home.
