Examination Findings:

- On November 17, 2021, N46370 (Cessna 152 airplane), was examined by the NTSB IIC and Alfred Louque (airframe and powerplant mechanic/inspection authorization) from Air Salvage of Dallas, in Lancaster, Texas.
- Both wings were removed from the fuselage to facilitate recovery from the accident site. Flight control continuity was established for the rudder. The left and right side brakes in the cockpit were manipulated multiple times and the left and right side brakes on the main landing gear functioned normally.
