- Bring photo ID with you.
- Refrain from eating and drinking large amounts of fluid before collection.
- Do not list your medications at the collection site.

## **COLLECTOR INSTRUCTIONS**

All FMCSA urine specimen collections and breath alcohol testing must be conducted in accordance with Part 49CFR40 of the FMCSRs. Collection procedures must include the following:

- Please use the CCF provided to you by CleanFleet or the employee. If a CCF is not provided, please contact CleanFleet at (503) 479-6082.
- If using a blank CCF, ensure that the appropriate account # is indicated on the CCF. For a Legacy Metro Lab CCF, it's account #4457. For a LabCorp Lab CCF, it's account #737708.
- Should any problems arise during collection and/or testing, contact CleanFleet at (503) 479-6082.
- To ensure proper documentation and prompt payment of your invoice for services, after collection and/or testing is complete, please do the following: Fax designated copies of the CCF and/or BAT result to the MRO at (503) 244-6790 and CleanFleet at (503) 978-1603.
