NARRATIVE

Dead Body/Accidental

Ryan Hundley was operating a Caterpillar 769C Off Road Dump Truck (Vehicle #1) in a southwesterly direction with a full load of limestone approaching a stop sign at a railroad crossing with no flashing lights or railroad gates. After stopping, Vehicle #1 proceeded forward and collided with the front left side of the first train car that was being pushed in a southerly direction by the Norfolk Southern train engine. The Conductor (Louis Shuster) was positioned outside on the front left side of the forward train car and was crushed between the front right side of Vehicle #1 and the front left side of the forward train car. The conductor was pronounced deceased on scene.

ASSIGNMENT: On Tuesday, March 7, 2023, while assigned to the Accident Investigation Unit (AIU) Car 7443, I received a page at 0205 hours to respond to 2615 West 3rd Street for a crash involving a train and an off road construction vehicle. 3S33, Sergeant Borden #9311, was requesting AIU. Fatal injuries were being reported and the incident number is 2023-00066334.

SCENE: At the location of 2615 West 3rd Street, I was directed by security personnel southbound to a gravel yard where several Cleveland Police and Norfolk Southern Police vehicles were on scene near the railroad tracks along with representatives from Cleveland Cliffs and TMS International. I observed a Norfolk Southern train engine facing a southerly direction with twelve train cars attached south of the engine. The furthest south tanker train car sustained heavy damage to the southeast corner of the car. A small, battery operated flashlight was located under the car in between the railroad tracks. East of the train, between the twelfth and eleventh car, the deceased victim was laying on the ground with obvious signs of trauma to the midsection and lower half of his body. Just north of the victim, a Caterpillar 769C off road dump truck with the cab located on the left side of the truck, was facing a southerly direction with minor damage to the front right. The scene was in final rest.

CCME Death Investigator Lydia Johnston was on scene to conduct her investigation.

The gravel yard of 2615 West 3rd Street is private property that was dimly lit with inadequate overhead lighting and no discernable roadway. An illuminated, flashing stop sign was located east of the tracks. The condition of the yard was poor being covered with mud and large puddles of water due to current rain and wet snow.

The on scene evidence consisted of the damaged train, victim and vehicle in final rest. The on scene evidence is consistent with the manner of occurrence reported.

<u>VEHICLE #1:</u> Caterpillar 769C, Off highway dump truck, yellow in color. VIN: X04043. Owner: TMS International. Address: 3 Summit Park Drive, Independence, OH, 44131. Telephone number: 440-526-9301. This vehicle sustained minor damage to the right front. This vehicle was carrying a full load of limestone and remained on scene.

<u>VEHICLE #2:</u> EMD GP 38-3, Train Engine, Black in color. Train ID: **5813**, VIN: **6251-15**. Owner: Norfolk Southern. Address: 1200 Peachtree Street NE, Atlanta, GA, 30309. Telephone number: 800-635-5768. This vehicle did not sustain any visible damage. This vehicle was pushing 12 train cars and remained on scene.

| MEASUREMENTS: The scene was mapped using the Trimble Type S5 Total Station S/N 37120182 with Ranger TSC3 Data Collector S/N TSC3111-002. The data was downloaded into Visual Statements VISTA FX3 software and stored under file number 23D-080. Two diagrams were generated from the data. |
| PHOTOGRAPHS: I took a total of one hundred-twelve (112) digital photographs of the vehicle and scene using the Canon EOS 90D digital camera. They were uploaded and assigned Photograph Log Number 23D-080. |
| WITNESS: No witnesses came forward or were present. |

SYNOPSIS: Ryan Hundley was operating a Caterpillar 769C Off Road Dump Truck (Vehicle #1) in a southwesterly direction with a full load of limestone approaching an illuminated, flashing stop sign at a railroad crossing with no flashing railroad lights or railroad gates. After stopping, Vehicle #1 proceeded forward and collided with the front left side of the lead train car (12) that was being pushed in a southerly direction by the Norfolk Southern train engine. The Conductor (Louis Shuster) was positioned outside on the front left side of the forward train car and was crushed between the front right side of Vehicle #1 and the front left side of the forward train car. The conductor was pronounced deceased on scene.

NOTES

- *The rear train car lacked any kind of lighting indicating it was moving in reverse.
- *The gravel yard and vehicle paths were dimly lit with overhead lighting.
- *The direction of travel for both the train and the Caterpillar created a visual obstruction for the operator of the Caterpillar due to the size of the dump truck and the cab position.

On April 13, 2023 I was requested to issue a UTT summons to Ryan Hundley by Prosecutors Oates and Bascone of the Cleveland Prosecutor's Office by way of Detective Bilko. After conferring with Sergeant Hartman, I issued a UTT summons for slow moving vehicles or equipment crossing railroad tracks (4511.64). The state code was provided to me by the Cleveland Prosecutor's Office.

DISPOSITION: Form-10 completed and Dead Body/Accidental FBR report completed.
