Crash Summary

About 11:32 p.m., on Saturday, June 16, 2018, a 2019 Volvo truck tractor in combination with a semitrailer was traveling eastbound on Interstate 84 in Boise, Ada County, Idaho. At the time of the crash Interstate 84 was reduced from four eastbound lanes to one lane for an ongoing maintenance project. A traffic queue had formed from the lane reduction. Near the Cloverdale overpass, a 2008 Jeep wrangler was at the end of the queue. The 2019 Volvo driver did not react for the stopped traffic and struck the rear of the Jeep forcing it into the rear of a 2003 Volvo tuck tractor in combination with a semitrailer. A post-crash fire ensued. As a result of the crash, three occupants of the Jeep were killed along with the driver of the 2019 Volvo truck tractor. Several other vehicles were damaged from contact, debris or the post-crash fire.
