Narrative:

In a telephone conservation with Mr. Pinksten to discuss "Blowing out the mags" on the B-17. To summarize the conservation: Mr. Pinksten indicated that on humid mornings, or after it had rained it was sometimes necessary to blow out the mags on the engines. He indicated this was a fairly common issue with radial engines and all four of the B-17 engines required "blowing out" from time to time to get them started. He further indicated that Sea Magnetos did not require as much blowing out as opposed to regular magnetos.
