Here are the things we are currently working on as a result of the Jackson, MS incidents that occurred in January 2024.

Post Incident Actions as of June 17, 2024 - Jackson, MS

Following the Atmos explosions in January 2024, the MPSC Pipeline Safety Division is reviewing the repaired and active leaks in the Jackson area, focusing on the areas immediately surrounding the incident sites. Some of the data being reviewed includes the advanced leak detection surveys that were run after the incidents, past leak surveys, 911 odor/leak calls, and leaks called in by customers and the public.

The MPSC is working with the Jackson police dispatch center and Atmos to identify gas leak calls that came into the 911 dispatch center over the past 18 months. The goal is to confirm that all leaks are reconciled in a timely manner.

The MPSC is reviewing Atmos leak grading procedures and how much discretion a technician has in grading leaks.

The MPSC has increased construction inspections in the Jackson area since the incidents. This is in response to the accelerated leak repair and pipe replacement activities in the Jackson area. The MPSC is monitoring Atmos repair and replacement progress.

The MPSC is reviewing the Atmos public awareness plan and the effectiveness of the program.

The MPSC is reviewing the timetable in which Atmos reported the incidents to the National Response Center as compared to the actual discovery of the incident.

This investigation is ongoing, and any enforcement actions will be considered at the conclusion of the investigation.
