Description Narrative

Between KMSY and KDFW the flight was approaching a line of weather. The captain made a PA announcement asking passengers to comply with the seat belt sign for the possibility of turbulence associated with the weather in front. After making the PA to the pax, the captain then called the FA's and told them to secure themselves for the same reason he told the pax. Approximately 10 minutes after penetrating the line of weather, the aircraft encountered a pocket of moderate turbulence. The turbulence only lasted a few seconds. Moments later we received a call from the FA's to inform us that one of the FA was hurt during the encounter with the turbulence and they were assessing her injuries. Again, moments later the FA's call back to inform us that medical personnel on the plane were advising to have her removed from the plane on a stretcher when we arrived. At that point we were on the arrival into KDFW. We then declared a Medical Emergency with ATC. We also informed the KDFW station to have medical personnel standing by at the gate we arrived.
