In response to your phone call, my statement follows. I tried to call the gato office but no live people to talk to.

At around 2:15pm Sat Oct 9th at KOKV my Luscombe 4581M tipped over on runout after landing. The passenger, Marcus Zechini made the landing which was a descent 3 point with no bounce and let the tail up too soon which caused the plane to start to deviate at which time I took over and over corrected with the brakes causing the plane to nose over. I am the owner of the plane and pilot in charge in the left seat. Brakes are only on the left side on this plane. I am a current tailwheel pilot and I have about 425 hours in Luscombe 4581M.
