

Additionally, he is well versed in handling static liquids and general products involved in problematic incidents.

Over the course of his career, Mr. Day has been involved in many of North America's worst chemical incidents including train derailments, chemical plant fires and explosions, warehouse fires, truck accidents, and massive petroleum releases into the environment. He has also been engaged by numerous industry clients to teach these subject matters to their personnel.
